Established in 2000 with the support of the Quality Education Fund, Hong Kong Education City ('HKEdCity') was incorporated in 2002 to become a wholly-owned company of the Government. Its mission is to enable to better adapt to changing curriculum initiatives through technology.

As the prime one-stop professional education portals in Hong Kong, the HKEdCity portal (www.hkedcity.net) is replete with information, resources, interactive communities and online services, which promote the use of information technology (I.T.) to boost the effectiveness of learning and teaching. It is also devoted to seizing new opportunities arising within the education sector.

HKEdCity is dedicated to developing high-quality online services across the region, with the aim of:

- Facilitating exchanges in educational resources and information among schools and teachers, while building a professional teachers' community;
- Encouraging students to make effective use of eLearning resources, as part of the growing trend of student-centric self-directed learning; and
- Empowering parents to nurture their children's whole person development and encourage them to become lifelong learners.

Through synergy arising from teachers, students and parents closely collaborating with our partners, we are proactively building an interactive service platform that is beneficial for both learning and teaching.

MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIRMAN 主席序言

Hong Kong launched the First Strategy on I.T. Education back in 1998. As this was among the most important strategies at that time, in 2000 the Government pioneered a visionary initiative to establish Hong Kong Education City (HKEdCity). Since then, HKEdCity has developed many online educational resources and services for schools, and conducted numerous workshops, seminars and conferences to build the professional community. All these efforts make HKEdCity one of schools' closest partners in eLearning.

Time flies, and 2015 marks the 15th Anniversary of HKEdCity. I am proud to be a member of HKEdCity during this important era, in which the Government officially launched the Fourth Strategy on I.T. in Education (ITE4) and outlined six important actions to support ICT in Education in the coming years. During many retreats and meetings, HKEdCity's Board of Directors has discussed one major theme: we have to leverage the strengths of HKEdCity to provide the best support for the education sector, and ultimately achieve our goal of improving teaching and learning quality through the innovative use of technology.

We have identified a number of initiatives which can help to implement ITE4, and enable Hong Kong to become one of the cities that best utilise technology in education. The key initiatives cover network infrastructure, learning management system, eResource, eBooks, eAssessment, single sign-on and mobile technology. Developing the professional community and facilitating a healthy partnership between schools and commercial sector are also key roles of HKEdCity, as reflected in the Learning and Teaching Expo, which attracted more than 8,000 participants in 2014 and is a signature event for education in this region.

HKEdCity first introduced EdBookShelf, to support eBooks, in September 2014. Our Business Development Committee has since explored various ways of developing new partnerships with publishers. I am glad that we have partnered with 26 publishers and organisations to develop digital contents on the EdBookShelf. I am especially pleased that we successfully launch the eRead Scheme in September 2015, with 13 publishers joining together to deliver an eBook library to schools at very low cost, which can ultimately benefit students.

I would like to take this opportunity to welcome our new Board members, Mr. Wong Kam Pui Wilfred, Ms. Loo Shirley Marie Therese, Ms. Ling Wai Shan Claudia Christian and Mr. Pang Tsz Kit Gabriel; and to express my gratitude to retiring Board members Mr. Kung Lin Cheng Leo, Dr. Lam Lee George, Mr. Yu Wing Fai Christopher and Mr. Chan Chi Tong Michel, each of whom has contributed significantly to HKEdCity over the past six years.

My heartfelt thanks also go to the hundreds of schools and partners for their valuable support for HKEdCity. While we celebrate our 15th Anniversary this year, we also look forward to opening a new page in the coming years with all our partners, teachers, parents and students.

2014年9月，「教城書櫃」正式推出。配合電子書市場的拓展，教城的業務發展委員會不斷探討與出版業界的各種協作模式。我感到喜悅的是教城已與26間出版社及機構合作，利用「教城書櫃」開發電子書；更令人雀躍的是，教城於2015年9月成功推出「e悅讀學校計劃」，與13間出版社共同建立電子圖書館，為學校提供實惠且優質的電子書籍，惠及所有學生。

藉此機會，我謹代表董事會歡迎新加入的董事會成員：黃錦沛先生、羅乃萱女士、凌蕙珊女士及彭子傑先生。另外，感激孔令成先生、林家禮博士、余榮輝先生及陳子堂先生四位剛卸任的董事會成員，在過去六年來對教城的重大貢獻。

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

行政總監報告

The Government officially launched the Fourth Strategy on I.T. in Education (ITE4) in August 2015. One of the key initiatives in this strategy is to support all government-funded schools in Hong Kong to have WiFi connectivity in all classrooms. This will enable all schools to be able to adopt technology in classrooms in future. With this very clear direction, HKEdCity is well positioned to support the current and future needs of schools in eLearning.

Our WaaSchool (WiFi-as-a-Service School) support model, based on HKEdCity EdConnect single sign-on, has been well received by schools since September 2014. All the major network service providers are partners of HKEdCity, and ready to support school WiFi networks with the WaaSchool model. We anticipate the scale of adoption to increase significantly in the coming years.

Our strategic product, EdBookShelf, has developed rapidly this year. We have partnered with 26 organisations and publishers, and have now completed about 600 eBooks, including many multimedia eBooks. The EdBookShelf platform has been further expanded to support school libraries. The eRead Scheme supports schools with subscribing to a package of a hundred books and making them accessible to all students. Our EdMall eResource shopping platform is growing steadily, and now we have 70 stores on the platform, providing more than 2,000 eLearning related products.

eResources is another key service of HKEdCity, and demand has been increasing because of the ITE4. We have adopted the Google Search Appliance to provide a much better search experience for eResources. We have applied this advanced search facility in HKEdCity Resource Depository as well as the Education Bureau One-Stop Portal. We have introduced a new Chinese language platform, Chinese Campus (知文識趣), to address increasing demand for Chinese language learning. TVNews continues to be the most popular learning platform, with 619 schools and almost 23,000 students participating and the other popular incentive scheme Summer Science also recorded over 18,400 participating students from 283 primary schools. Building on the success of the Summer Science, we introduced the brand new Summer English program riding on the advantage of EdBookShelf.

Our infrastructure design and operations must keep pace with the increasing demand for and crucial role of our services. We moved to a TIA-942 tier-3 grade data centre in December 2014. We have also piloted cloud infrastructure, to provide fault tolerance for critical infrastructure services. During the year, we had a few intermittent database issues that affected a few hours of operation. Overall, we achieved over 99.9% availability.

Looking Forward

The ITE4 will have increasing impact on eLearning in Hong Kong. In 2015/16, there will be another batch of 300 schools implementing WiFi, bringing the total number of such schools to about 800. The demand for eLearning resources and support will continue to grow. STEM education is also a priority area in many schools, where innovative pedagogy in STEM will naturally involve more in-depth use of ICT. HKEdCity has formulated our 3-year business plan and will prioritise our support in the following areas:

- Continuing our role as eLearning market facilitator, to partner with organisations to introduce both free and paid eResources for schools;
- Leveraging our existing strengths of eRead Scheme, EdBookShelf and Hong Kong Reading City to facilitate a large scale deployment of reading with low costs for books and ease of administration by schools;
- Collaborating with IT vendors in infrastructure and learning systems to simplify school infrastructure and system support, so that

schools can adopt eLearning with a good foundation for infrastructure and focus more on learning and teaching rather than handling technical support; and

- Building on the success of Learning and Teaching Expo and the Go eLearning platform to continue developing the eLearning community among teachers and the industry.

Last but not least, I would like to present my gratitude to our more than a hundred partners who have adopted our EdMall, EdBookShelf, EdConnect and WaaSchool services. Together, we are building a strong community to provide better eLearning support to schools. In marking our 15th Anniversary, I also wish to thank our long-term school partners, teachers and members of various advisory committees who have spent many hours in meetings and events to help us improve our services.

於2015年8月，政府正式啟動《第四個資訊科技教育策略》，重點策略之一是資助全港公營學校，為所有課室裝設無線網絡「WiFi」，讓學校能充分利用資訊科技融入學與教。對焦這明確的推展方向，教城正能發揮所長，全力支持學校現在及未來電子學習發展的需要。

以「教城EdConnect單一登入服務」為基礎，而延伸發展的「WaaSchool」（WiFi-as-a-Service School）支援服務，自2014年9月推出以來，深受學校歡迎。各主要的電訊供應商均成為了教城的伙伴，並準備就緒，以「WaaSchool」模式為全港學校提供無線網絡服務。預計未來數年，採用「WaaSchool」服務模式的學校數量將有顯著的增幅。

教城的另一重點項目「教城書櫃」，由去年全新啟用至今，發展迅速，除了成功與26間機構及出版社合作，製作了約600本包含不少多媒體元素的電子書，教城更推出嶄新的「e悅讀學校計劃」，以閱讀組合的方式提供100本電子書予學校訂閱，進一步拓展「教城書櫃」以支援學校圖書館，更讓學生隨時隨地享受閱讀。而「教城購物廣場」亦穩步發展，現有70間商店，提供逾2,000項電子學習相關的產品以供選購。

因應《第四個資訊科技教育策略》，學界對電子資源的需求日益增加，搜羅優質教學資源亦成為教城的重點服務之一。為讓用戶輕省地搜尋適切的電子資源，「教學資源庫」及「教育局一站式學與教資源平台」均採用了Google搜尋引擎（Google Search Appliance），以提升用戶的搜尋經驗。回應學界對中國語文學習資源的需求，教城推出全新的中文平台「知知識趣」，協助老師教學及學生自學。一向深得學校歡迎的學習平台「TVNews」，年內共有619間學校、約23,000名學生參與，而受小學生愛戴的「暑期數理常識挑戰計劃」亦吸引共283間小學、逾18,400名學生參與。汲取「暑期數理常識挑戰計劃」的成功經驗，今年首度使用「教城書櫃」推出全新的暑期英語計劃「Summer English」。

面對學界對電子學習的重視，教城的服務亦愈趨重要，因此我們的基建設計及運作亦須不斷求進，以緊貼科技發展的步伐。2014年12月，教城採用設備達TIA-942第三級別設計標準的數據中心，同時亦試行雲端基建，提升系統的容錯空間，保障至為關鍵的基建服務。於年內，教城網站曾因數據庫出現間歇事宜而影響了數小時的運作，但總體而言，仍可提供99.9%穩定的網絡服務。

今年，我們在「教城書櫃」的運作及保安、保護個人資料政策（會員）及伙伴合作政策進行了內部審計，所有審計工作均順利完成，亦無發現重大風險問題。

展望未來

《第四個資訊科技教育策略》會繼續對本港的電子學習發展有著舉足輕重的影響。於2015/16學年，另有300間學校將安裝無線網絡，屆時全港將有800間學校配備無線網絡，學界對電子學習資源及支援的需求亦會不斷增加。此外，新銳的教學模式將愈來愈倚重資訊科技，包括不少學校均重視的科學、科技、工程及數學（STEM）教育。有見及此，教城已訂立三年的業務計劃，支援以下範疇：

- 繼續肩負市場倡導者的角色，與不同機構協作，為學界引進免費及收費的優質電子資源；
- 透過「e悅讀學校計劃」、「教城書櫃」及「香港閱讀城」，讓學校減省購書成本及行政工作，大規模推展全校閱讀；
- 與不同的學習平台及基建供應商合作，簡化學校的基建及系統支援工程，使學校擁有發展電子學習的穩健基礎，毋須再為技術問題費神，得以專注於學與教；及
- 善用「學與教博覽」及「Go eLearning」網站的優勢，助教師及業界壯大電子學習的互動社群。

HKEdCity is honoured to have received the Social Capital Builder Award presented by the Community Investment and Inclusion Fund of the Labour and Welfare Bureau. This is the second consecutive year that Teacher TV and Inclusion Pavilion have won this award, which serves as an encouraging acknowledgement of our efforts to promote eLearning in Hong Kong.

● Unceasing progress throughout 15 years 跨越 · 突破十五載



HKEdCity was founded in 2000 as Hong Kong Education City, and incorporated as a limited company in 2002. Throughout the past 15 years, technology has undergone tremendous development and affected almost every part of our lives, including learning and teaching. HKEdCity's strategies and services have also evolved and been transformed in the past 15 years. 15 years ago, we started helping schools adopt computers in teaching and leverage internet resources. We have since supported broadband connectivity for schools, operated email services, hosted school websites, and delivered eLearning resources through our education portal.

In recent years, we have begun helping schools implement eLearning through new channels, such as enabling mobile learning in every classroom, self-directed learning with learning platforms, Flipped Classroom, eAssessments, digital reading, and enabling integration of third party contents and solutions into schools.

To make eLearning sustainable with quality resources available, we switched from inhouse eResource development to partnership and open platform solutions. Third party solutions and commercial solutions are all vital components of the eLearning ecosystem. To support third party developers and commercial partners, we introduced EdConnect for single sign-on and EdBookShelf for education eBooks. Our eAssessment platform also supports assessment items from different sources. During 2015, we introduced a new development involving learning data, which will lay a foundation for future education data analytics to provide considerable amounts of useful feedback to eLearning schools. With support from the industry, we now have over 100 partner companies and organisations involved in delivering our services.

To celebrate unceasing progress during our 15 years, HKEdCity is organising a series of celebration programmes to share our achievements and joy with stakeholders, including the 'eLearning Builder Award' to recognise schools that are actively engaging students and teachers in eLearning, and 'What is 15? – Photo Collection Campaign' on Facebook to spread the joy of our 15th anniversary and connect stakeholders through social media. An eBook (with the Chinese title '電子學習 跨越 · 突破') will be published, consolidating the eLearning experiences from the last 15 years and planning for the decade ahead.

教城創建於2000年，前稱為香港資訊教育城，於2002年註冊成為香港教育城有限公司。過去十五年間，資訊科技發展一日千里，改變了我們生活的每一部分，包括學與教模式，而教城的業務策略和服務亦不斷與時並進。十五年前，我們開始推動學校使用電腦及運用網上資源教學，並支援學界設置寬頻網絡，建立校內電子郵件系統和校園網站，以及於我們的教育平台上發放網上學習資源。

近年，我們建立了新的平台，助學校推行電子學習，例如助師生於課堂中使用流動裝置，建構不同的學習平台讓學生自主學習，推動翻轉課堂（Flipped Classroom）、電子評估、網上閱讀。教城更與其他機構合作，整合不同的學習資源和資訊科技解決方案，供學校使用。

電子學習有賴高質素的學習資源方可持續發展，伙伴以及企業所提供的資訊科技解決方案至為關鍵。因此，教城由內部開發教學資源，轉為透過伙伴合作模式發展網上資源，同時亦推動開放式平台。為了支持軟件開發商和企業等合作伙伴，教城不但推出了「EdConnect用戶目錄服務」，以提供單一登入服務，更開發了「教城書櫃」，供學界及公眾使用電子書，更透過「網上試題學習平台」，整合不同機構及出版商提供的考試題目。2015年，教城引入學習數據方面的新發展，為未來的數據分析奠下基礎，並為學校推行電子學習提供一定規模的實用數據。在學界及業界的支持下，已有超過100間機構成為教城的合作伙伴，攜手推動我們的服務。

為了慶祝15年來的努力，教城將舉辦一系列慶祝活動，與不同的持分者分享我們的成果與喜悅，包括「教城15周年 - 電子學習動力大獎」以表揚學校積極推動師生投入電子學習，及在教城Facebook專頁舉辦「15的意義」圖像徵集大行動，通過社交媒體與不同的持分者分享我們踏入15周年的喜悅。電子書《電子學習 跨越 · 突破》亦將出版，以總結過去15年的電子學習經驗並規劃未來10年的發展。

KEY INITIATIVES 重點工作



This year, we have seen fruitful eLearning developments in Hong Kong. The key services provided by HKEdCity align closely with the Fourth Strategy on I.T. in Education and the upcoming STEM education. Our primary role is to promote and support schools in Hong Kong with adopting innovation and digital resources to improve learning and teaching. One of our key initiatives is playing a unique role as an eLearning Market Facilitator. Our partners now cover publishers, WiFi service providers, platform service providers, education product companies, NGO, etc. Our other key initiatives aim to support schools, teachers and students through our education portal in providing eResources, Online Platforms, Online Services and Information. These online services are supplemented by various events and activities.

今年，本港的電子學習發展取得豐碩成果，教城的服務亦緊扣《第四個資訊科技教育策略》及科學、科技、工程及數學（STEM）教育的趨勢。當中的首要任務，是推動及支援學界善用創新科技及電子資源，提升學與教質素，而發揮市場倡導者的獨有角色，推廣電子學習，更是箇中關鍵。我們的合作伙伴包括出版商、網絡供應商、平台服務供應商、教育產品公司、非政府機構等。此外，教城亦以教育網站的形式，為學界提供電子資源、網上平台、網上服務及資訊，並配合多元化的活動，支援學校、教師及學生。

EdConnect



EdConnect is a single sign-on service, launched as an enhancement to the comprehensive HKEdCity membership system, enabling each user to get access to different eLearning resources and platforms while using WiFi authentication with a single HKEdCity account. This spares schools the effort of creating and maintaining multiple user accounts in order to connect to multiple service providers. The service obviates the hassle of collecting and creating a user account for each service provider. By 31 August 2015, 20 vendors had joined the service for online platforms.



As one of the major advocates of eLearning in Hong Kong, HKEdCity proactively enhances information technology infrastructure in schools and explores possibilities for helping schools implement eLearning. In 2013, working together with the Association of I.T. Leaders in Education (AiTLE), HKEdCity established a new WiFi network service pioneer project – WiFi as a Service School Partnership Project (WaaSchool), to provide schools with convenient and easy-to-access WiFi networks, empowering our future generations with an innovative learning paradigm.

The Fourth Strategy on I.T. in Education, announced by the Education Bureau, highlighted the importance of eLearning through strengthening schools' I.T. infrastructure and equipping all classrooms with WiFi access. In accordance with this, WaaSchool has been expanded to cover the 'Support Scheme for eLearning in Schools' and facilitate use of eLearning resources in class. HKEdCity continues working with network service providers to offer a WiFi connection authentication service, which will improve students' participation in class and self-directed learning.



With joint efforts from local network service providers, WaaSchool aims to build a one-stop-platform model similar to mobile network service providers, in which HKEdCity acts as a facilitator and caters for end-user services ranging from infrastructure, through design of wire networks and routine maintenance, to custom services. Together with the EdConnect single sign-on service provided by HKEdCity, schools and network providers can save tedious work and the cost of managing thousands of accounts, as teachers and students can simply sign on to school WiFi networks with their existing HKEdCity accounts to conduct eLessons. By 31 August 2015, 120 schools were using WaaSchool.

「EdConnect 用戶目錄服務」(EdConnect) 以現有完善的會員系統為基礎，提供單一登入服務，讓用戶以一個帳戶輕鬆連結各種電子學習資源和平台，及作為WiFi認證。「EdConnect」服務令學校毋須逐一為服務供應商建立及管理大量帳戶，即可連接至不同的服務供應商，減省繁瑣的帳戶管理工序。截至2015年8月31日，已有20名供應商參與EdConnect服務。

作為香港電子學習的主要倡導者，教城積極推動學界提升資訊科技基建，探討學校推行電子學習的機遇。在2013年，教城聯同資訊科技教育領袖協會 (AITLE) 建立及推出了一個嶄新的WiFi服務支援模式——「WaaSchool 伙伴計劃」(WaaSchool)，為學校提供方便易用的WiFi服務，讓新生代有一創新的學習模式。

教育局公佈的《第四個資訊科技教育策略》強調需提升學校資訊科技基建，讓所有課室均配備WiFi，以推動電子學習。有見及此，教城擴展「WaaSchool」至「電子學習學校支援計劃」，以推動師生在課堂中使用電子學習。教城繼續透過「WaaSchool」與不同網絡服務供應商緊密合作，提供便捷的WiFi認證服務，助學生積極參與課堂，自主學習。

透過與本地網絡服務供應商合作，「WaaSchool」冀建立如流動電話網絡般的一站式平台，為使用者提供完善的服務，由基建、網絡設計、系統維護，以至客戶支援服務等，一應俱全。配合教城的「EdConnect」單一登入服務，學校及網絡服務供應商可省卻管理眾多帳戶的繁瑣工序，師生只需以教城的會員帳戶登入學校WiFi網絡，便可進行電子課堂。截至2015年8月31日，共有120所學校使用「WaaSchool」服務。

EdBookShelf is a unique electronic bookshelf for promoting eLearning, enhancing the effectiveness of learning and teaching, while assisting partners with unlocking markets for eBooks and eResources in Hong Kong. Unlike other electronic bookshelves in the market, EdBookShelf has a unique cross-platform feature with single sign-on function and synchronisation in the cloud, and options to construct personalised learning environments. It supports multi-media eBooks with all-in-one interactive learning tools – including Cantonese/Putonghua/English Text-to-Speech, free-drawing, book-marking, note-taking and annotation functions.

This unified, integrated electronic bookshelf platform can support the whole eBook supply process – from ordering and delivering, to activating and reading, all of which requires just a few clicks, maximising convenience for users. Through collaboration with publishers, companies and schools, the platform offers diverse learning and teaching resources and interactive contents, allowing users to start their innovative and fruitful eLearning journeys with EdBookShelf. The second phase development of EdBookShelf system was completed by the end of August 2015. Now, it is equipped with a learning data saving function, laying a solid foundation for open learning data. Over 600 eBooks were available for public use by the end of August 2015.

「教城書櫃」是專為配合促進電子學習、提升學與教效能，並協助合作伙伴開拓香港電子書及電子資源市場而設的電子書櫃。有別於市場上的電子書櫃，教城書櫃獨家備有跨平台、單一登入及雲端同步儲存功能，以建立個人化學習環境。教城書櫃支援多媒體電子書，內置多項互動學習工具，包括涵蓋廣東話、普通話及英語的三語發音功能、讓用戶可繪畫、標示書籤、註明筆記、螢光筆畫重點等功能。

e·悅讀 學校計劃



Building on the uniqueness of EdBookShelf and aiming to help schools fully utilise I.T. in Education and promote reading with minimum administrative resources, the new service **eRead Scheme** is being developed to enable schools to have annual subscriptions to an affordable eBook package with over 100 book titles spanning multiple publishers, English and Chinese, different themes and learning stages. Students may enjoy unlimited access to the eBooks in the package throughout the subscription period. In 2015/16, the scheme is launched on a trial basis, allowing pilot schools to provide feedback for enhancing the scheme so that it shall be suitable for attracting subscriptions from more schools in the second term of 2015/16. To date, the scheme has attracted 13 publishers to provide several hundred books for selection; the 38 pilot schools selected 100 books for primary schools and another 100 books for secondary schools.

“

eRead Scheme allows teachers to promote reading in an easy and effective way. When there's an ebook recommendation through Campus TV, teachers can prepare electronic reading materials provided by the Scheme, greatly reducing administrative work. Also, the Scheme resolves the limitations arising from accessing numbers of quantity of physical printed access to particular titles, boosting convenience for teachers when advocating several reading materials at one time.

The ability to log-in to the platform by HKEdCity student accounts is another advantage, as they are familiar with this login pattern. Its cross-platform design enables users to read books without being affected by device limitations. Teachers can also easily understand students' reading habits and progress by analysing individual reading data provided by the Scheme.

The interface for eBooks' introduction and selection is user-friendly, enabling teachers to select suitable books for recommendations or integrating in teaching activities. eReading is a trend suiting the needs of a new generation of students. This scheme provides quality books with eLearning tools, which can undoubtedly cultivate students' good reading habits.

Resources 學習資源



Resources Depository is a one-stop portal designed to hold quality resources for inspiring lesson preparation and instructional design. To enhance the learning and teaching materials and user experience, HKEdCity provides the Education Bureau with ongoing support for developing the Education Bureau One-stop Portal for Learning & Teaching Resources. The rich resources cover Chinese Language Education, English Language Education, Mathematics Education, Science Education, Personal, Social and Humanities Education, Technology Education, Physical Education, Arts Education, General Studies, Liberal Studies, and Cross Key Learning Areas/Curricula.

Additionally, HKEdCity encourages teaching professionals, NGOs and educational institutions to share their quality resources in the Resources Depository, to assist teachers with readily enhancing the contents of their lessons. To optimise user experience, Resources Depository has been upgraded with a brand new interface and a more powerful search engine, enabling teachers to more easily explore teaching resources.

By the end of August 2015, there had been almost 1.5 million downloads¹ from the resources depository.

「**教學資源庫**」為一站式教學資源網站，提供高質素的學與教資源，協助教師備課和進行教學設計。為提升學與教資源質素及改善用戶經驗，教城持續支援教育局一站式學與教資源平台的發展。平台資源豐富，涵蓋中國語文、英國語文、數學、科學、個人、社會及人文教育、科技教育、體育、藝術、小學常識和高中通識教育及跨學科／課程。

另外，教城也鼓勵專業教師、非政府機構和教育機構把優質資源分享到「**教學資源庫**」，方便教師獲取更多優質的教學資源，增潤課堂。為提升用戶經驗，「**教學資源庫**」已優化版面，使用全新界面及更強大的搜尋器，方便教師尋找適切的教學資源。截至2015年8月底，資源庫共有近1,500,000個下載^{註1}。

Inclusion Pavilion is a multifunctional information and resources platform, geared to the needs of inclusive education development. It is well stocked with articles, teaching strategies and school-based experiences relating to different special educational needs, aiming to enhance knowledge and understanding of teachers and parents regarding common special educational needs and inclusive education policies. This will assist teachers and parents with developing proper teaching methods that can address learner diversity, promote inclusive culture, and achieve whole person development. Over 200 resources were available by the end of August 2015, and five themed seminars were held, attracting over 1,100 registrants, to provide a meeting place for teachers and parents to mingle with experts, and share ideas and experiences.

“ Inclusion Pavilion provides us with practical information, and the seminars help us a lot. With professional speakers such as clinical psychologists and experienced teachers, parents and teachers can gain more extensive and reliable knowledge of various special education needs. ● Teacher Professional Development 教師專業發展



Teacher TV is an online video station, designed to support the professional development of teachers. Capitalising on new media technology, this platform helps teachers consolidate their professional knowledge through online self-learning, class observation, and sharing good teaching practices in other schools. This in turn facilitates the building of an online culture that combines interactive learning and knowledge sharing with stronger bonding within professional communities. During the 2014/15 school year, 747 videos were available.



A series of offline conferences, seminars and hands-on workshops have been organised, to inspire teachers and enable them to exchange ideas with experts and scholars from different professional areas, covering topics such as development of eLearning and eAssessment, support needed for special education programmes in both special and mainstream schools, and multimedia production for the betterment of education.

“After the platform enhancement, it is easier for us to search the right videos, whereas Teacher TV is accessible using different browsers and devices, so we can browse both education & professional development information.”

TVNews is an interactive English learning platform. It features online self-learning and assessment functions, to engage students in self-assessment for language improvement through multimedia English clips and online exercises. These exercises feature short English news clips, coupled with vocabulary and comprehension exercises, as well as discussions to help students sharpen their listening, reading, writing and speaking skills, in addition to stimulating their interest and developing their skills in critical thinking regarding social issues.




During 2014/15, TVNews was widely promoted to primary and secondary schools as a whole-year programme consisting of exercises for school terms, followed by a summer incentive scheme. It attracted participation by 619 schools – representing 58% of schools in Hong Kong – and engaged 23,000 unique users during the year to learn about English and current affairs.




知文識趣



Chinese Campus has been newly established to support Chinese teaching and students' learning needs. The platform collects self-learning activities and teaching resources which are categorised into six main learning areas at primary and secondary levels: reading, writing, listening and speaking, literature and Chinese culture, language knowledge, as well as learning and teaching for Non-Chinese Speaking (NCS) students. In the second phase development, there will be exercises for students supporting self-directed learning.

為支援教師中文教學及學生自學需要，教城推出全新中文學與教平台「知文識趣」，平台集「閱讀」、「寫作」、「聆聽及說話」、「文學及中華文化」、「語文知識」和「非華語學生的學與教」六大範疇，各範疇均設自學活動及教學資源推介，分中、小學程度，全面照顧師生不同需要。「知文識趣」將於下階段推出學生自學練習。





暑期 數理常識 挑戰計劃



Summer Science is a summer incentive scheme, which encourages students to engage in the world of science and mathematics via game-based learning. It is designed to promote and facilitate self-learning related to science in the General Studies and Mathematics curricula at the primary school level. Rich multimedia learning contents contributed by Children Science are transmitted through exciting games, to fully realise the effectiveness of game-based learning and increase students' engagement. During 2014/15, the platform engaged 18,493 unique users from 283 primary schools. The top five schools will participate in an offline final contest at the end of October 2015, to compete for the highest honour. To celebrate the scheme's 10th anniversary, two newly developed cross-platform games will be launched, so students can enjoy participating in the online games using mobile devices at any time, anywhere.

Additionally, 10-minute Science, an online learning platform coupled with multi-media learning and diverse assessments to enrich students' knowledge of general studies and science during school calendar months, attracted participation by 123 primary schools, with more than 6,800 unique students during the school terms.

“ Our school has been encouraging students to spark their self-learning ability, as well as curiosity about and knowledge of science, via eLearning platforms. With HKedCity's 10-minute Science, students can explore knowledge online in their spare time, which arouses their interest in science and improves their problem solving skills. The Platform introduces various areas of knowledge in a simple way, so that students can grasp science concepts within 10 minutes. This motivates their self-learning, and they are eager to join the 10-minute Science program. ”

「暑期數理常識挑戰計劃」為暑期獎勵計劃，鼓勵學生以遊戲形式學習數學及科學知識。計劃旨在促進小學生自學數學及常識科中的科學範疇，將《兒童的科學》所提供豐富的多媒體學習材料，製作為緊張刺激的遊戲，引發學生的學習興趣，充份展示遊戲為本的學習成效。2014/15年度，計劃吸引了283所學校參加，每月使用者達18,493名，成績最為優異的五所學校將於2015年10月參加總決賽，爭奪最高殊榮。為慶祝「暑期數理常識挑戰計劃」十周年，教城在2015年10月加推兩個全新跨平台的數理遊戲，讓學生隨時隨地使用流動裝置體驗網上遊戲的樂趣。

此外，為配合多媒體學習及多元化的評估，教城於學期內推出網上學習平台「十分科學」，以豐富學生的常識及科學知識。這些學習活動吸引了123所小學參加，學年間有多達6,800名學生參與。

網上試題 學習平台 Online Question Bank



Online Question Bank (OQB) is an award winning online learning platform designed to facilitate ‘assessment for learning’ and ‘assessment as learning’. OQB aims to enable teachers to better understand each student’s learning progress and performance, and explore their learning potential. This can help teachers to adjust and formulate effective teaching strategies, and develop individual study plans that cater to learning diversity. It also aims to reinforce and strengthen students’ learning through assessments and instant feedback, to support them with preparing for the HKDSE.

OQB has partnered with HKEAA since 2009, and in 2014/15 provided over 4,000 questions from past public examination papers covering nine subjects: English Listening, Chinese Listening, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Economics, Geography and ICT. The collaboration has been expanded to content providers including the Hong Kong Educational Publishing Company, the Modern Educational Research Society, the Hong Kong Economic Journal, and Mr. Albert Wong Kin Wai, the IT Coordinator and Computer Subject Panel Head of Lee Kau Yan Memorial School, to provide almost 2,800 free questions covering Mathematics, Biology, Liberal Studies and ICT for all secondary students, so they can experience effective learning via assessment. The questions were categorised by year, topic, level of difficulty and relevancy to the New Senior Secondary (NSS) curriculum. With flexible filtering tools and powerful analytical reports, students were empowered with personalised assessment and self-evaluated learning progress reports. During 2014/15, the service attracted subscriptions from 124 secondary schools and 90 individual users, covering 26% of Hong Kong secondary schools.

“ Our schools subscribed to Online Question Bank (“OQB”) last year and students have shown significant improvement in a few months. After the first year, our students performed better than their counterparts in HKDSE, especially those using OQB, which reflected how OQB caters for assessment for learning. We shall promote mobile learning in the near future in line with OQB. HKEdCity has bridged the local education sector to facilitate IT in education, which benefits students. ”

「網上試題學習平台」是專為「促進學習評估」及「作為學習的評估」而設，並曾獲獎項的網上學習平台。平台服務旨在助教師掌握每個學生的學習進度和表現，並發掘其學習潛能，以調節及制定有效的教學策略，就個別學生設計針對性的學習計劃，從而拉近學習差異。另一方面，平台亦希望支援學生準備香港中學文憑考試，助他們透過評估和即時回饋鞏固所學知識。

自2009年起，平台獲香港考試及評核局支持，於2014/15年度提供超過4,000條歷屆公開考試題目，包括英文聆聽、中文聆聽、數學、物理、化學、生物、經濟、地理和資訊及通訊科技科等。教城也與其他內容供應商及老師合作，包括香港教育圖書公司、現代教育研究社有限公司、信報及李求恩紀念中學的資訊科技統籌主任及電腦科科主任黃健威老師，提供約2,800條免費題目，包括數學、生物、通識教育、資訊及通訊科技科，以幫助中學生通過評估，提升學習效能。平台的題目以年份、課題、難度和與新高中課程的相關度分類，配合靈活的篩選工具和強大的分析報告，為學生提供個人化評估，透過自我評核檢視學習進程。於2014/15年度，有124所中學和90名個人用戶訂購網上試題學習平台服務，全港中學覆蓋率超過26%。

“本校於上年度開始使用網上試題學習平台，利用此評估性學習工具，學生能夠在短短數月內，在測考上有顯著進步。在首年推行之後，本校考生在香港中學文憑試的成績普遍比同類日校考生的成績為佳，應用網上試題學習平台的學科成績尤其卓越，喜見此平台的效果。在可見將來，本校在校內積極推動移動學習，亦會繼續推廣使用試題庫。在此方面，香港教育城無疑能擔當統合本地學界的角色，推動本地學界資訊科技發展，讓更多莘莘學子受惠。”

EdV, known as Educational Video, is a free school-based video platform to facilitate the development of using multimedia in and beyond classrooms. The EdV Awards advocate the application of multimedia in learning and teaching to improve learning efficiency, and entered their fifth year in 2014/15. This year's awards attracted over 260 learning and teaching videos, most of which were submitted together with recommended lesson plans or learning materials to reveal their learning and teaching concepts as well as their support for sharing amongst the community. The 'Flipped Classroom Application Award' was established this year, encouraging over half the participants to produce a video together with a set of multiple choice questions as a student assessment, to support this popular teaching pedagogy and experience its effectiveness in learning and teaching.

During the five years of cultivation of multimedia in education, over 1,000 masterpieces were produced by in-service teachers, pre-service teachers and students, and received for sharing within the education sector. The submissions included demonstrations, experiments, thematic studies, and performances related to learning and teaching. To further cultivate the use of multimedia in schools, the school-based video service is now free for primary and secondary schools in Hong Kong to use for uploading, storing and sharing videos through their self-managed platform, while teachers and students can produce and share creative media learning and teaching resources with their peers. By the end of August 2015, there were 242 schools fully utilising this school-based service.

“ Our school adopted Flipped Classroom in several subjects in different classes this year. We came across EdV while searching for platforms with abundant space for file saving. EdV provides us not only with sufficient space, but also a one-stop exercise feature. Students only have to login with their HKEdCity accounts to watch videos assigned to their class, and finish exercises afterwards. The Platform can even count how long each students watches a video, and consolidate their scores in exercises, so that teachers can follow up with them – which is a great help to us. ”

「EdV」意指教育短片，是為全港學校免費提供的校本短片分享平台服務，旨在進一步推動學與教上的多媒體應用，提升學習效能。教城於2014/15年第五度舉辦EdV獎勵計劃，共收到260條學與教短片作品，而大部份的短片配有完整的教案或教材，以展示其學與教理念及支持資源共享。因今年新增設「翻轉課堂應用獎」，鼓勵老師以創新模式教學，達至教學相長，有一半參賽者的參選短片，都加設了選擇題供學生作答。

教城過去五年致力於推動學界應用多媒體，現已收集千多段短片與學界共享，作品均由現職教師、職前教師和學生製作，內容包括課堂示範、科學實驗、學科專題研究、各項活動表演及生活百科常識等。為繼續推動多媒體教學，教城現為全港中小學提供免費短片平台服務，學校可自行管理平台，上載、儲存及分享教學短片，教師和學生也可以製作並分享他們的多媒體學與教資源。截至2015年8月，已有242所學校應用此校本服務。

Hong Kong Reading City is a popular online service fostering Read-to-Learn and Learn-to-Read cultures among education stakeholders. It aims to build a Read and Share culture among schools, encouraging Hong Kong students to learn from extensive reading and form good reading habits. The platform provides a comprehensive range of reading services for schools, including Reading Board, Reading Contract, Online Reading Club and other online resources. By employing information technology, the Reading Contract encourages students to read on their own initiative, and systematically records their reading progress, inspirations and thoughts. Teachers can understand their students' learning behaviour and capabilities through a management system, and hence formulate appropriate reading and learning strategies. In 2014/15, 129 schools joined as 'Reading Schools', with over 2,002 students participating in the Reading Contract and over 16,644 books read.

Furthermore, the annual Ten Books Selection event was organised, inviting students to vote for their favourite books and authors in order to provide encouragement for authors and publishers. A brand new award – 'Publicly Recommended Book' – was launched this year, encouraging our members to recommend good books to students. There were 16,110 votes recorded. Many awardees cherished their awards, and shared their joy on site.

“ Thank you HKEdCity for organising ‘Ten Books Selection’, which broadens our horizons through the Trial Reading service, providing us with opportunities to read more books and learn of more writers. We look forward to again joining such a meaningful activity in the coming year.

Teen Campus is a healthy learning platform with life and personal growth knowledge for teenagers, aiming to unleash their personal potential. With diverse and interactive learning resources and activities, the platform encourages teenagers to learn beyond the classroom and equip themselves with 21st Century skills, and thus form a new generation with a love of exploring and sharing. Diverse online and offline learning programmes were organised for teenagers to enrich their knowledge in academic subjects like Liberal Studies, develop critical thinking skills, equip themselves with information on life planning, and provide professional advice on difficulties they may face while growing up.

Student Explorer is a programme combining the key elements of the Other Learning Experience and the Project-based Learning programmes related to Liberal Studies. It aims to enhance holistic thinking, research skills and project-based writing techniques through experience-based learning. Student Explorer allows participants to explore different aspects of society by joining diverse activities organised by HKEdCity or other institutions, and then sharing their thoughts in the form of ePapers (探知電子報). This year, HKEdCity collaborated with Radio Television Hong Kong for 'LS Online Challenge', Hong Kong Economic Journal for 'Hong Kong Liberal Studies Financial Literacy Championship' and Educational Publishing House for 'NSS Maths Online Challenge', aiming to equip students with basic information on social and current issues covered in the six Liberal Studies learning areas as well as become familiar with the question types of Mathematics of HKDSE. During the year, 11,654 students from 200 schools participated in various programmes.

Learning & Teaching Expo



The **Learning & Teaching Expo (LTE)** is an annual event through which teachers, school leaders and educators in Asia can discover the latest developments in educational resources and learning technology. The Expo serves as an opportunity for everyone involved in providing education to exchange ideas about learning and teaching in the 21st century. HKEdCity jointly organised the Expo in 2014/15 – its fifth year, with an international professional exhibition organiser, Diversified Communications Hong Kong, and received full support from the Education Bureau, UK Trade and Investment, the UK's National Association for Special Education Needs (nasen) and the British Educational Supplies Association. This led to an overwhelming response from participants, with 231 exhibition booths, including UK and Finland pavilions, showcasing the latest overseas learning solutions and products, together with more than 100 conferences, forums, workshops and school visits presented and led by internationally renowned scholars and local professionals. These features helped to attract over 8,000 unique visitors, 72.4% of whom were from Hong Kong, with others from countries and regions including China, Taiwan, Macau, South Korea, South East Asia, Australia, Canada, the USA and the UK. The Expo not only provides a platform for connecting local education professionals, but also allows them to participate in international exchanges regarding the latest ideas in education.

Learning & Teaching Expo



Parent Academy is a one-stop online resources platform for parents. It collects articles, videos and information from various professional institutions and experts, and groups them into three major categories: 'Parenting and Growth', 'Learning Support' and 'Future Planning'. Focused on more than just school results, the platform is committed to helping parents develop their children's proper behaviour, attitudes and positive values, so as to nurture whole person development for new generations and allow parents to learn and grow with their children.



A series of events for Parent Education on eLearning, jointly organised with AiTLE and supported by the Education Bureau, began during 2014/15. A conference, 3 seminars and 12 parallel sessions of open lessons were conducted, for parents to understand and experience eLearning, equipping them to become their children's companions in learning journeys. In order to increase parents' awareness on eLearning, a roadshow named 'Family Fun Learning Carnival' was organised at a shopping arcade on Mothers' Day. Over 1,000 parents were reached.

Also, two parents' seminars were conducted during 2014/15: 'Paving the Way to Secondary School' and 'Learning Liberal Studies with Children'. Parents were also invited to join our 5 SEN seminars during the year.

「家長童學」是專為家長而設的一站式網上資訊平台，匯集各專業機構及專家的文章、影片、資訊等，並以「教養及成長」、「子女學習支援」和「子女升學選校」三大範疇為骨幹，助家長從良好的教養、正確的態度和價值觀入手，培養出全人發展的新一代，沿途與孩子一同學習，一起成長。

於2014/15學年，教城與教育局及資訊科技教育領袖協會攜手，開展一系列【e世代·家長童行】活動，包括一個研討會、三場講座及十二場公開課，讓家長親身體驗電子學習的好處，並了解相關的熱門議題，助他們裝備自己，成為子女學習路上的好伙伴。為提升家長對電子學習的關注，教城亦於母親節期間，在商場舉辦「親子e學遊蹤」，吸引了逾千名家長參加。

此外，今年教城亦舉辦了兩場家長講座，包括「並肩同行升中路」及「與子女活學通識科」，另外五場有關特殊教育的講座，亦吸引不少家長會員踴躍參與。

EdPost provides the latest trends in education and shares valuable expert insight for subscribers. It has been enriched, such as through incorporating an educational newspaper that features education news, talk-of-the-town topics, and the latest learning and teaching resources and information updates. Both HKEdCity members and non-members can subscribe to EdPost via email. By the end of August 2015, there were over 103,000 subscriptions.

● Technology and Infrastructure 技術和基礎設施

HKEdCity has made good preparations to support the rapid development of eLearning in Hong Kong, especially the introduction of mobile learning and eTextbooks. Various infrastructure elements and services have been developed and reviewed to support HKEdCity's unique position in promoting and facilitating the eLearning market.

In December 2014, we relocated servers and other equipment to a TIA-942 tier-3 grade data centre. The process was completed smoothly, within the scheduled maintenance period.

With the maturing of cloud infrastructure, HKEdCity has deployed some services and internal systems using popular cloud services on a pilot basis. By leveraging the scale and reliability of cloud infrastructure providers, we can increase the efficiency and reliability of our services.

Apart from enhancing the reliability and scalability of school WiFi services to cater for growth in the number of participating schools, additional features have been developed to allow schools to control the numbers of user connections via their service providers.

面對香港電子學習的急速發展，尤其是流動學習及電子教科書，教城已準備就緒，建立並不斷改善一系列基礎建設及服務，以奠定教城作為推動電子學習的市場倡導者角色。

教城於2014年12月把伺服器等設備遷往達TIA-942第三級別設計標準的數據中心。這次搬遷按原定期限順利完成。

有見雲端基礎設施日趨完善，教城於是以試點形式將一些服務及內部系統放置於雲端運作。藉著雲端服務供應商既可靠又能靈活擴展的雲端服務，提升了教城服務的效率及穩定性。

隨著越來越多學校在校內裝設WiFi，教城除了加強學校WiFi網絡服務的可靠性和可擴展性外，還增設了額外的功能，讓學校可經其網絡服務供應商控制學生流通裝置連接WiFi的數量。

Operated largely with the support of government funds, HKEdCity upholds a high standard of corporate governance, maintains reliable and accurate financial reporting and emphasises social responsibility in order to ensure sustainable development of the Company.

教城的經營資金主要來自政府，故奉行高水平的企業管治，維持可靠和準確的財務報告，並強調社會責任，以確保公司可持續發展。



● Corporate Governance 企業管治

Governance Structure²

In 2014/15, the Board of Directors had eleven members, who were appointed by shareholders. The Board is the highest governing body, overseeing the Company's strategic development and ensuring it operates in compliance with statutory requirements. Under the Board, the Executive Committee is typically chaired by the official director, to monitor and give advice on the Company's operational matters. Further, the Business Development Committee, with eight directors appointed by the Board, governs all the Company's business developments, including EdMall and EdConnect, etc.

In May 2015, four new directors were appointed in place of the retiring directors. During 2014/15, three Board Meetings, three Executive Committee Meetings and one Business Development Committee Meeting were held, with attendance rates of 70%, 100% and 88%, respectively. Declarations of interest were made by all directors for the year. No director has received any remuneration.

As of 31 August 2015, the Company maintained a total headcount of 62, with three divisions: Systems and Operation, Development, and Administration and Finance. The most up-to-date Organisation Chart is in Appendix 1.

管治架構²

2014/15年度，董事會有11名成員，由股東任命，組成機構最高的領導層，負責監管公司的發展策略，並確保其運作符合法定要求。董事會下設執行委員會，由官方董事擔任主席，負責定期監察公司的營運，及提供建議。此外，由8位董事組成的業務發展委員會則負責監管公司的業務發展，包括「教城購物廣場」及「EdConnect用戶目錄服務」等。

2015年5月，四名新董事被委任以接替卸任的董事。2014/15年期間，教城舉行了3次董事會會議，3次執行委員會會議及1次業務發展委員會會議，出席率分別為70%、100%及88%。全體董事已申報本年度的利益，概無董事收取任何酬金。

教城由系統及營運部、發展部和行政及財務部三個部門組成，截至2015年8月31日，員工總數為62人。最新的公司架構圖見附錄一。

Risk Management

HKEdCity has a Risk Management Policy in place to govern risk management. In 2014/15, the risk register was updated, and measures to address the risks identified were implemented. We also revised the internal audit plan to prioritise and assess the potential risks that may occur in the changing business environment. The risk mitigation measures were implemented accordingly. Audit exercises concerning personal data privacy protection (membership), partnership engagement and EdBookShelf operation and security were conducted. No significant issue was observed during the audits.

HKEdCity also constantly reviews and streamlines its policies and procedures. In 2014/15, the policies relating to information technology security, incident management, capital asset management, partnership engagement were revised in order to support the business development. Internal Human Resources policies such as Leave Policy and Work Arrangement in times of Typhoon and Rainstorm were also updated.

風險管理

教城制定了風險管理政策以監察公司的風險。在2014/15年度，教城更新了風險登記冊，並積極採取一些緩解措施以減低存在的風險。我們亦修訂了內部審計計劃，以重新評估及監察潛在的風險。風險緩解措施也相應地推行了。本年度的審計項目包括保護個人資料政策（會員）、伙伴合作政策以及教城書櫃服務運作與保安。全部均如期完成，並無發現重大的風險問題。

同時，教城亦不斷檢討及簡化其政策和程序。在2014/15年，教城修訂了有關資訊科技保安、危機處理、固定資產管理及伙伴合作等政策，以配合業務的發展。另外，員工休假政策以及颱風或暴雨警告下的工作守則也進行了更新。

Staff Development

As staff members are among the most valuable assets of a company, HKEdCity puts great emphasis on organising staff development programmes and activities, to enhance the capability of staff as well as promote staff relations and morale.

教城視員工為公司最寶貴的資產。因此，教城十分重視推動員工發展計劃和組織員工活動，從而提高員工工作能力，以及維繫員工之間的關係和提升士氣。

Staff Training and Team Building

The Company strives to provide staff development programmes to enhance the professional skills and knowledge of its staff members in order to meet business needs and the challenges ahead. Staff members were nominated to attend external seminars and conferences, as well as various training workshops and seminars, which included Problem Solving Skills, Protection on Personal Data Privacy, IT Security, Partnership Management, eAssessment, Social Media, and Occupation Health and Safety. During the year, approximately 116 man-days were invested on staff training, and the average training time per member of staff was approximately 1.9 man-days.

To promote staff relations and morale, the Company also organised various staff activities including Celebration Lunch, Christmas Party, and New Year Lunch. Recreational activities like badminton and bowling and special interest class like Tai Chi was also organised, to promote a healthy lifestyle.

員工培訓和團隊建立

教城致力為員工提供培訓計劃，提高員工的專業技能和知識，以滿足業務需求和迎接挑戰。獲提名的員工可參加外間機構舉辦的研討會和會議，以及各種培訓工作坊，其內容涉及解決問題技巧、個人資料及私隱保障、資訊科技保安、伙伴管理、電子評估、社交媒體及職業健康及安全等。年內，教城投放了約116天於員工培訓，平均每名員工的培訓時間約為1.9天。

為了增進員工之間的關係和提升士氣，教城還舉辦各種員工活動，包括慶祝聚餐、聖誕派對、團年飯等；另外亦組織了不同的康樂活動及興趣班如羽毛球、保齡球及太極班，以推廣健康的生活方式。



Pay Review

To maintain market competitiveness in retaining talent, HKEdCity conducted an annual salary review of its staff members in 2014/15, with consideration of the market pay trend reports, HKEdCity's financial status and internal factors. The Board approved the budget for salary increments and performance incentives for 2014/15. Total remuneration of the top three tiers of management amounted to HK\$7.74 million.

薪酬檢討

為了保持在招聘和挽留人才方面的市場競爭力，教城在考慮市場薪酬趨勢報告、公司的財務狀況及內部因素後，進行了2014/15年度薪酬調整檢討，並獲董事會批准薪酬調整和表現獎金的發放，最高三層管理人員的薪酬合共774萬港元。



● Financial Report 財務報告

HKEdCity continues to maintain prudent and effective use of public money which complies with statutory accounting requirements, and maintains a healthy financial status with adequate financial planning and control as well as proper financial records throughout the period.

In the 2014/15 financial year, the Company continued to sustain a healthy and steady financial position. The total income and expenditure of subvented activities for the year was HK\$37 million. As of 31 August 2015, the Company had total non-current assets of HK\$6.5 million and current assets of HK\$16.8 million. Total net assets of the Company amounted to HK\$1.5 million. HKEdCity received HK\$40,000 in cash donations and in-kind donations of 2,000 books, magazines, stationeries and accessories. The donations are designated for eLearning development and promotion of better learning and teaching through our services. Overall, the Company's liquidity was in very good condition throughout the year, as cash and bank deposits amounted to HK\$15 million by the end of the financial year. The accounts of subvented and non-subvented activities were kept separately.

教城一貫謹守法定的會計準則，審慎及有效地運用公帑，並在期內保持充足的財務規劃和監控，及完善的財務記錄，以維持穩健的財務狀況。

2014/15財政年度，公司繼續保持穩健的財務狀況。本年度受資助活動的總收入和支出均為36,968,361港元。截至2015年8月31日，公司非流動資產及流動資產總額分別為6,539,336港元及16,788,425港元。公司的資產淨值總額為1,487,763港元。教城亦接受了40,000港元的現金捐贈和2,000件實物捐贈包括書籍、雜誌、文具及配件。這些捐贈已用作我們推廣電子學習及教城各項學與教服務。總括而言，公司全年保持良好的資產流動性，截至2015年8月31日止的年度現金及銀行存款總額達15,029,890港元。政府資助和非政府資助活動的帳目是明確分開的。

Expenditure of Subvented Activities

Regarding the expenditure for subvented activities, staff costs totalled HK\$24 million, accounting for 64.8% of the total expenditure.

As for capital expenditure, HKEdCity spent HK\$1.6 million to acquire fixed assets including computer equipment, storage systems, software licences and office facilities.

政府資助活動的開支方面，員工薪酬開支總額為23,966,738港元，佔總支出最大的份額，達64.8%。資本開支方面，教城支出共1,649,785港元以購買固定資產包括電腦設備、存儲系統、軟件和辦公室設備。

● Corporate Social Responsibility 企業社會責任

Shouldering corporate social responsibility to the community is one of HKEdCity's missions. Our ongoing contribution to society has been widely recognised by the Social Capital Builder Award, Gold Award of the Web Accessibility Recognition Scheme, Caring Company Award and Good MPF Employer Award. We are committed not only to providing a quality workplace to our staff, but also to prudent operating practices and remaining active in the community, to create a positive impact in the community.

- In order to provide staff with a quality and safe work environment, HKEdCity has family-friendly policies such as paternity leave, marriage leave, compassionate leave, and compensation leave. HKEdCity also implements various occupational health measures in order to promote and enhance staff health and safety at work. Through the annual employee satisfaction survey, the Company collected staff members' valuable opinions on how to improve the HKEdCity workplace.
- During the year, HKEdCity also supported its voluntary team and staff to participate in voluntary or charity activities or services such as flag selling for Hong Kong Playground Association, and participating in UNICEF Charity Run 2014.
- HKEdCity donated a substantial number of books to Hans Andersen Club Limited, thus helping children from grassroots families to read. Besides, our obsolete office computers and accessories were donated to Caritas Computer Refurbish Project which aims to recycle computers for the people in need.
- Aiming to promote the value of social responsibility to vendors, HKEdCity stipulates procurement specifications requiring vendors to meet the minimum wage requirement, protect intellectual property rights and personal data, observe health and safety standards, etc.

肩負企業社會責任一直是教城的任務之一。教城對社會的持續貢獻得到了廣泛的認同，榮獲「社會資本動力獎」、「無障礙網頁嘉許計劃金獎」、「商界展關懷」標誌及「積金好僱主」等獎項。教城不僅致力為員工提供優質的工作環境，還提倡謹慎實務的工作及積極參與社區活動，希望對社區產生積極的影響。

- 為了提供優質及安全的工作環境給員工，教城不但制定了家庭友善政策，例如侍產假、婚假、恩恤假、補假等，同時也推行了不同的職業健康措施，以保障員工健康和工作安全。透過每年的員工滿意度調查，教城更收集了員工就如何改善教城工作環境的寶貴意見。
- 年內，教城亦積極支持義工隊及員工參與義務工作、慈善活動或服務，如為香港遊樂場協會賣旗、聯合國兒童基金會慈善跑2014等。
- 此外，教城捐贈了大量書籍予安徒生會有限公司，幫助來自基層家庭的兒童提供閱讀書籍。此外，教城亦將舊電腦及配件捐贈予「明愛電腦循環再用計劃」，經翻新後送給有需要人士使用。
- 為向供應商宣揚社會責任的價值，教城通過採購條款要求供應商遵守最低工資的規定、保護知識產權和個人資料，及遵守職業健康和 safety 標準等。
