THE COMPANY 關於教城



Established in 2000 with the support of the Quality Education Fund, Hong Kong Education City (HKEdCity) was incorporated in 2002 to become a wholly-owned company of the Government. Its mission is to enable better adaptation to changing curriculum initiatives through technology.

As the prime one-stop professional education portal in Hong Kong, the HKEdCity portal (www.hkedcity.net) is replete with information, resources, interactive communities and online services, which promote the use of information technology (I.T.) to boost the effectiveness of learning and teaching. It is also devoted to seizing new opportunities arising within the education sector.

HKEdCity is dedicated to developing high-quality online services across the region, with the aim of:

- Facilitating exchanges in educational resources and information among schools and teachers, while building a professional teachers' community;
- Encouraging students to make effective use of eLearning resources, as part of the growing trend of student-centric self-directed learning; and
- Empowering parents to nurture their children's whole person development and encourage them to become lifelong learners.

Through synergy arising from teachers, students and parents closely collaborating with our partners, we are proactively building an interactive service platform that is beneficial for both learning and teaching.

香港教育城（教城）（前稱香港資訊教育城）於2000年在優質教育基金資助下成立，並於2002年公司化，成為政府全資擁有的公司，致力推動學界利用資訊科技適切配合課程變革。

教城的一站式專業教育網站www.hkedcity.net，結合資訊、資源、互動社群與網上服務於一身。教城承諾與時並進，以成為業界倡導者為己任，全力推動學界透過資訊科技提升學與教效能，與教育界同業並肩迎接新機遇。

教城一直致力發展跨地域的優質網絡平台，藉此：

MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIRMAN 主席序言

This is my fourth year as the Chairman of the Board of Directors of Hong Kong Education City Limited. The Government launched the Fourth Strategy on I.T. in Education (ITE4) in 2015, and outlined six important actions to support ICT in Education in the coming years. As of today, about 70% schools are already equipped with WiFi in all classrooms, and we expect the figure to surpass 90% in September 2017. I am glad to witness this rapid development of eLearning in Hong Kong, with HKEdCity being one of the key players supporting schools.

I am grateful for the dedication and commitment of all Board Directors. We have conducted many strategic discussions to identify what roles HKEdCity can best play to support education in this rapid changing environment. We have seen HKEdCity navigating through a successful period of promoting and supporting eLearning through the web portal, which continues to be the largest education portal in Hong Kong. At the same time, we also anticipate changing needs moving forward, as eLearning has become part of core teaching and learning activities instead of something supplementary. This implies that HKEdCity's services and infrastructure will become ever more critical to schools; and there will be a need for sophisticated learning platforms instead of just websites, and rich eBooks and contents for students rather than just eResources for teaching. HKEdCity will continue to formulate new initiatives to support this changing eLearning environment and capture its opportunities.

We have developed a comprehensive business plan for the coming years. In a nutshell, the key initiatives comprises Virtual Learning Environment, eAssessment and EdBookShelf to support reading. Taking EdBookShelf as an example: we first released this platform in 2014, and within just two years, there were already more than 1.2 million books distributed to the students. We anticipate achieving similar rapid growth in eAssessment and in the Virtual Learning Environment.

HKEdCity cannot achieve the mission alone. We have more than a hundred partners spanning businesses, NGOs and educational institutions, working together to develop an eLearning ecosystem that can provide schools with the best solutions.

My heartfelt thanks also go to the hundreds of schools and teachers for their invaluable support to HKEdCity. We will continue our quest for excellence in education through technology and innovation.

我出任香港教育城董事會主席已是第4個年頭。政府於2015年推出《第四個資訊科技教育策略》，勾劃出6項重要的行動綱領，以支持未來資訊科技教育的發展。直至今日，約7成學校已在所有課室設置WiFi，而發展至2017年9月，有關數字將逾9成。我欣喜能見證香港在電子學習方面急速發展，而教城更在當中擔當支援學校的重要角色。

教城有此成就，感謝一眾董事會成員的貢獻及承擔。透過多次策略性會議及討論，落實教城在這急速轉變的環境下應擔當的角色，以最高效地支援教育界。我們喜見教城多年來的努力，透過其專業教育網站，成功地推廣及支援電子學習，至今仍是香港最大的一站式專業教育網站。與此同時，我們預計學界的需要因應環境而會持續轉變，當電子學習成為教與學的其中一個核心部分，而不再是輔助性質時，意味著教城為學校提供的服務及基礎設施的支援將變得更舉足輕重。學界需要的不單是一個網站和教學用的電子資源，而是具多功能的學習平台，並整合電子書及其他內容，為學生提供豐富的電子書藏和學習資源。未來，教城會繼續推陳出新，以支援變革中的電子學習環境及抓緊轉變中帶來的機遇。

我們已制訂全面的業務發展計劃，為未來數年發展定立明確的方向，包括虛擬學習環境 (Virtual Learning Environment, VLE)、電子評估及支援閱讀的教城書櫃。以教城書櫃為例，自2015年首度推出以來，短短兩年間，已為學生派遞了逾120萬本的電子書。預計電子評估及虛擬學習環境兩大項目的推展，亦會經歷相似的急速增長。

要完成這些任務，教城會透過與逾百個伙伴如商界、非牟利機構、教育學府的多元協作，攜手發展一個完善的電子學習生態環境，為學校提供最佳的方案。

我衷心感謝數以百計學校和教師，為教城提供無價的支持，我們將透過科技及創新，繼續在教育上追求卓越。

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT 行政總監報告

In anticipation of the change in the eLearning landscape — especially with the government launching the Fourth Strategy on I.T. in Education (ITE4), HKEdCity planned several strategic initiatives three years ago, and the new services are now widely adopted by education sector.

Our WaaSchool (WiFi-as-a-Service School) support model, which leverages our single sign-on infrastructure, was first started as a pilot for 33 schools and two network service providers in 2013/14. This year, we have about 400 schools in the scheme, and 13 network service providers have infrastructure integrated with HKEdCity.

A WiFi testing tool was launched in June 2016, enabling schools to conduct efficient and automated evaluations of the WiFi performance in a real mobile classroom environment. This tool is very popular, and has been used by more than 60 schools to conduct more than 1,000 tests. We strongly believe that a stable WiFi classroom with a good performance is instrumental to large scale implementation of eLearning. We are glad to see that Hong Kong schools widely recognise the benefits of using this WiFi as a service model.

Rapid development has continued with our strategic product that supports reading, EdBookShelf. We have partnered with 26 organisations and publishers and developed over 850 eBooks, including many multimedia eBooks. There are over 1.2 million eBook subscriptions, for users from 243 schools. We successfully launched the eRead pilot scheme in 2015/16, with 38 pilot schools, using packages of 100 eBooks from commercial publishers. Based on the successful concept of eBook packages, we expanded the scheme with additional packages of free eBooks. As of 31 August 2016, we have a total of 72 schools using the free or paid eBook packages through EdBookShelf. We will further expand the scheme in 2016/17, with new packages including 200 eBooks, and continue to engage more local and overseas publishers in increasing the variety of available eBooks.

We began a mobile strategy in 2013, with the vision that all HKEdCity services should be mobile-friendly and accessible to users via all popular mobile platforms. We have now completed this long journey by upgrading all our major websites with responsive design. We have redeveloped Small Campus—our most popular game-based learning platform — to support mobile devices with apps for iOS and Android. Over 101,000 users have been using the Small Campus this year which represents 9.4% growth after a gradually declining trend in the last few years. Our newsletters and electronic communications with users have also migrated to a new platform, to provide a good mobile experience for our users.

eResource is another key service of HKEdCity. The eResources download rate has significantly increased from about 1.4 million to over 2.3 million downloads from 2015 to 2016, reflecting the increasing interest from teachers. We have upgraded our system with a more user-friendly interface and a powerful search engine based on the Google Search Appliance, to help teachers find useful resources more easily.

Looking Forward

We anticipate that more than 90% of schools will be equipped with WiFi by August 2017. Many schools have accumulated experience in using various eLearning tools and eTextbooks. Many are also exploring new pedagogies and tools for STEM education. The eLearning ecosystem is becoming more complex, with content and solutions from different service providers. It is evident that eLearning platforms, solutions and contents need to follow some industry standards, so that schools do not have to use many different systems for different subjects, and the student data and assessment data from different platforms can be managed holistically.

Unlike the burgeoning stage of eLearning, in which the focus is on classroom teaching and tools, a more mature stage of eLearning will require an in-depth understanding of student learning behaviour, analyses of student performances, eAssessments and timely feedback to students etc. This more in-depth level of eLearning can only be supported in systematic ways within a Virtual Learning Environment (VLE). HKEdCity has conducted seminars for the industry and schools about the need for eLearning standards, and has started a VLE pilot project with participation by 19 schools. This pilot project will have important implications for future large scale implementation of VLE in Hong Kong.

Another very important new project for HKEdCity is an eAssessment platform called STAR, which is a collaboration with the Hong Kong Examinations and Assessment Authority (HKEAA) and the Education Bureau. We have initially migrated the Student Assessment platform from HKEAA to HKEdCity. The new system supports mobile devices, and has a number of enhancements. Further down the road, we will expand the platform's functions and assessment items to provide broader support for eAssessment. This will be a significant project to help schools make the best use of eAssessment to improve learning and teaching.

The government has given HKEdCity a HK\$10 million grant for acquiring local and international commercial eLearning contents and solutions for schools. This can quickly increase the availability of quality contents and platforms, and let schools have wide exposure to various education technologies. HKEdCity will also collaborate with international education technology companies – not just well-known global IT companies, but also innovative companies from Finland and other countries with good education solutions. Our aim is to enable Hong Kong schools to have exposure to the forefront of education technology innovations, and be able to adapt and use them in Hong Kong.

Lastly, I would like to thank our long-term school partners, teachers, and members of various advisory committees who have worked closely with us in many projects. Particular thanks to the schools under the Centre of Excellence Scheme of the Education Bureau for sharing their expert experience in eLearning and giving advice and assistance to other schools. Together we are building a strong and effective community to nurture the advancement of education in Hong Kong.

有見於電子學習的環境不斷轉變，加上政府啟動《第四個資訊科技教育策略》，教城於3年前已著手準備及推展多項策略性服務，而這些服務亦得到教育界廣泛地應用。

以單一登入服務為基礎的 WaaSchool (WiFi-as-a-Service School) 服務，於2013/14學年以先導形式推出。服務由最初的33間先導學校及2個服務供應商參加，現已發展至400間學校採用和13個服務供應商參與。

今年6月，教城推出WiFi測試工具，透過模擬學生進行電子學習課堂的真實狀況，讓學校能有效率且自動化地測試學校WiFi表現。測試工具廣受學校歡迎，至今已有逾60間學校使用，合共進行逾1,000次測試。穩定及質素良好的WiFi有助於大規模實踐電子教學，我們樂見這WiFi服務模式得到香港學校的廣泛認同。

教城另一項支援閱讀的重點服務「教城書櫃」亦持續迅速發展，成功與26個機構及出版商合作開發逾850本電子書，包括多本多媒體電子書。現時有234間學校使用此服務，訂閱量逾120萬本。「e悅讀學校先導計劃」於2015/16學年推出，以閱讀組合的形式提供100本電子書予學校訂閱，有38間先導學校率先使用。有見電子書組合的成功，計劃延伸至提供更多的收費及免費電子書組合，直至2016年8月31日，已有72間學校透過「教城書櫃」訂閱電子書組合。計劃將於2016/17學年進一步擴展，為學校提供200本電子書的新組合，並會繼續與更多本地及海外出版商合作，增加電子書種類。

於2013年起，教城開始全面更新網站服務，目標是令所有教城服務與流動裝置相容，可於所有主要流動平台上使用。這漫長工程現已大功告成，所有主要網頁已升級至支援智能電話的響應式設計 (Responsive Design)。最受學生歡迎的遊戲化學習平台「小校園」亦開發出適用於iOS及Android的流動應用程式，讓用家可在流動裝置上登入「小校園」。經歷了過去數年「小校園」的使用率輕微下降，今年已回升並吸引逾101,000名學生使用。而「教城電子報」及電子通訊亦已轉用新平台，讓用家能有更好的瀏覽體驗。

電子資源是教城另一焦點服務。教城電子資源於2015至2016年期間的下載率錄得顯著增長，由約140萬次急增至230萬次，反映教師對電子資源的需求。升級的系統配合更方便易用的介面設計和Google搜尋引擎 (Google Search Appliance)，能提昇教師的搜尋體驗，幫助他們更容易取得有用的資源。

展望未來

我們預期逾9成學校在2017年8月將已配備無線網絡，更多學校將累積了使用電子教學工具及電子教科書的經驗，不少學校亦會開始為STEM教學探索新教學法及工具。與此同時，由於不同的服務供應商提供的內容及方案各異，電子教學的生態環境將會愈見複雜。因此，電子教學平台、方案及內容必須依循一些業界標準，學校才可統一管理不同的學科教材和學生的評估數據。

電子教學的發展已益趨成熟，有別於起步階段時聚焦於課堂教學及工具階段，現時學校更需要的是深入了解學生的學習行為和分析學生的表現，以及能夠提供即時回饋予學生的電子化評估。因此，學校必須有系統性的虛擬學習環境 (Virtual Learning Environment, VLE) 支援，才能達致更深入的電子教學。教城已為業界及學界舉辦多場講座，講解電子教學標準化的需要，並開展「VLE先導計劃」，目前共有19間學校參與。有關計劃對於將來在香港大規模應用VLE，具有重要意義。

教城另一重要項目電子化評估平台「STAR」，是由香港教育局、香港考試及評核局及教城共同協作。「學生評估」系統從香港考評局遷移至教城平台，新系統提昇了不少功能，並適用於流動裝置。下一步我們將擴充更多功能及評估庫，為電子化評估提供更多方面的支援。這項具標誌性的項目將有助學校善用電子化評估提昇學與教效能。

政府亦向教城撥款一千萬元，為學校搜羅及提供本地及海外教學資源，包括電子教學內容及方案，這將可快速增加優質電子教學內容及平台的供應，同時讓學校廣泛接觸不同的教育科技。教城亦會與國際教育科技公司協作，當中除了國際知名的公司，亦有來自芬蘭等國家，以及提供優質教育方案的創新公司。我們的目標是讓香港學校有機會接觸到頂尖教育創新科技，並應用於香港。

最後，我衷心感謝在多個項目上緊密合作的長期學校伙伴、教師，以及各諮詢委員會成員。特別銘謝教育局轄下資訊科技教育卓越中心學校，感激他們在學與教上提供專業及寶貴的意見，並為其他學校提供支援。未來，就讓我們繼續攜手建立強大而有效的社群，共同促進香港教育的進步。

HKEdCity was founded in 2000 as Hong Kong Education City, and incorporated as a limited company in 2002. Throughout the past 15 years, technology has undergone tremendous development and affected almost every part of our lives, including learning and teaching. HKEdCity's strategies and services have also evolved and been transformed in the past 15 years. Fifteen years ago, we started helping schools to adopt computers in teaching and leverage internet resources. We have supported broadband connectivity for schools, operated email services, hosted school websites, and delivered eLearning resources through our education portal.

To celebrate unceasing progress in these 15 years, HKEdCity has organised a series of celebration programmes to share our achievements and joy with stakeholders, including the 'eLearning Builder Awards' to recognise schools that are actively engaging students and teachers in eLearning, and 'What is 15? — Photo Collection Campaign' on Facebook, to spread the joy of our 15th anniversary and connect stakeholders through social media. A book (with the Chinese title '電子學習 跨越·突破') was published in electronic and printed format, consolidating the eLearning experiences from the last 15 years and planning for the decade ahead. This year, we have seen ongoing fruitful eLearning developments in Hong Kong. The key services provided by HKEdCity align closely with the Fourth Strategy on I.T. in Education and STEM education. Our primary role is to promote and support schools in Hong Kong with adopting innovation and digital resources to improve learning and teaching. One of our key initiatives is to play a unique role as an eLearning Market Facilitator. Our partners now span publishers, WiFi service providers, platform service providers, education product companies, NGOs, etc. Our other key initiatives are to support schools, teachers and students through our education portal, by providing eResources, online platforms, online services and information. These online services are supplemented by various events and activities.





EdConnect is a single sign-on service based on the HKEdCity membership system, enabling HKEdCity members to access multiple third party eLearning resources and platforms using single HKEdCity accounts. This spares schools the effort of creating and maintaining multiple student accounts in order to access online services from different service providers. By 31 August 2016, 26 vendors and 879 schools were using EdConnect.

In 2013/14, HKEdCity launched a new **WiFi-as-a-Service School Partnership Project (WaaSchool)** jointly with the Association of I.T. Leaders in Education (AiTLE). WaaSchool introduced a new WiFi service model based on EdConnect so that teachers and students can use the same HKEdCity account for WiFi authentication in schools.

As of 31 August 2016, about 400 schools under the WiFi 900 scheme were using this service, a substantial increase from 120 schools in 2015. A new feature has been introduced, enabling schools to have flexible control of WiFi access by level, class and individual.

A WiFi testing tool was launched in June 2016, enabling schools to conduct efficient and automated evaluation of the WiFi performance in a real mobile classroom environment. More than 60 schools have used the tool, and more than 1,000 tests have been performed.





“ Our school has joined the WaaSchool Project organised by HKEdCity and AiTLE. Through the one-stop service, teachers can use WiFi reliably, and spend more time focusing on the design of eLearning lessons, even though they lack technical know-how regarding WiFi set-up. They do not need to worry about the WiFi setting, installation of hardware and security problems while using the tablets. Students can connect to WiFi by using HKEdCity ID as authentication. They also enjoy the roaming services provided. It is easy and convenient for students to login to different platforms through the single sign-on system. Joining WaaSchool Project helps reduce the problems the teachers and students faced with procedures for WiFi settings and applications. Learning and teaching activities are more effective. The project also supports schools which lack IT technicians to implement eLearning in schools. ”

「EdConnect 用戶目錄服務」(EdConnect) 以現有完善的會員系統為基礎，提供單一登入服務，讓用戶以一個帳戶輕鬆連結各種電子學習資源和平台，及作為WiFi認證。「EdConnect」服務令學校毋須逐一為服務供應商建立及管理大量帳戶，即可連接至不同的服務供應商，減省繁瑣的帳戶管理工序。截至2016年8月31日，已有26名供應商及879所學校使用EdConnect服務。



教城聯同資訊科技教育領袖協會 (AiTLE) 於2013/14學年推出了**「WaaSchool伙伴計劃」(WaaSchool)**，WaaSchool為學界引入了以EdConnect為基礎的嶄新WiFi服務支援模式，師生可使用其教城帳戶作為校內的WiFi認證。

截至2016年8月31日，約400間已參與WiFi900計劃的學校採用本服務，較2015年約120間學校有明顯增長。今年，教城為服務加入了另一新功能，讓學校更彈性地按程度、年級或個別師生，控制WiFi的登入。

今年6月，教城進一步推出WaaSchool測試工具，模擬學生進行電子學習課堂的真實狀況，助學校以具效率及自動化的方法測試網路表現。至今已逾60間學校使用此測試工具，合共進行逾1000次測試。

EdBookShelf is a comprehensive electronic bookshelf for promoting eLearning, enhancing the effectiveness of learning and teaching, while assisting partners with unlocking markets for eBooks and eResources in Hong Kong. Unlike other electronic bookshelves in the market, EdBookShelf has a cross-platform feature with single sign-on function and synchronisation in the cloud, and options to construct personalised learning environments. It supports multi-media eBooks with all-in-one interactive learning tools—including Cantonese/Putonghua/English Text-to-Speech, free-drawing, book-marking, note-taking and annotation functions.



This unified, integrated electronic bookshelf platform can support the whole eBook supply process—from ordering and delivering, to activating and reading, all of which requires just a few clicks, maximising convenience for users. Through collaboration with publishers, companies and schools, the platform offers diverse learning and teaching resources and interactive contents, allowing users to start their innovative and fruitful eLearning journeys with EdBookShelf. Starting from August 2015, EdBookShelf has incorporated a learning data saving function, laying a solid foundation for open learning data. Over 850 eBooks were available for public use by the end of August 2016.

Building on the uniqueness of EdBookShelf and aiming to help schools fully utilise I.T. in Education and promote reading with minimum administrative resources, the brand-new **eRead Scheme** has been developed to enable schools to annually subscribe to an affordable eBook package with over 100 book titles spanning multiple publishers, English and Chinese, different themes and learning stages. Students may enjoy unlimited access to the eBooks in the package throughout the subscription period. In 2015/16, the scheme was launched on a trial basis, allowing pilot schools to provide feedback for enhancing the scheme so that it shall be suitable for attracting subscriptions when officially launched in 2016/17. Up to 31 August 2016, the scheme has attracted 13 publishers to provide several hundred books for selection; 38 pilot schools selected 100 books for primary schools and 100 books for secondary schools.



“ eRead Scheme facilitates more effective development of online reading by schools, and helps students read eBooks more easily. We can read books anywhere and anytime. Resources Depository is a one-stop portal designed to hold quality resources for inspiring lesson preparation and instructional design. To enhance the learning and teaching materials and user experience, HKEdCity provides the Education Bureau with ongoing support for developing the Education Bureau One-stop Portal for Learning & Teaching Resources. The rich resources cover Chinese Language Education, English Language Education, Mathematics Education, Science Education, Personal, Social and Humanities Education, Technology Education, Physical Education, Arts Education, General Studies, Liberal Studies, and Cross Key Learning Areas/Curricula.



Additionally, HKEdCity encourages teaching professionals, NGOs and educational institutions to share their quality resources in the Resources Depository, to assist teachers with enhancing the contents of their lessons. To optimise the user experience, the Resources Depository has been upgraded with a brand new interface and a more powerful search engine, enabling teachers to more easily explore teaching resources.

By the end of August 2016, there had been over 2.3 million downloads* from the resources depository.

“ Class preparation can make teaching effective. Teachers must handle a heavy workload every day, but still have to seize every single minute for class preparation. The Resources Depository of HKEdCity is the most effective and easiest way for teachers to locate suitable resources including notes, worksheets, images, recordings, videos, educational TV and other flash clips. 「教學資源庫」為一站式教學資源網站，提供高質素的學與教資源，協助教師備課和進行教學設計。為提升學與教資源質素及改善用戶經驗，教城持續支援教育局一站式學與教資源平台的發展。平台資源豐富，涵蓋中國語文、英國語文、數學、科學、個人、社會及人文教育、科技教育、體育、藝術、小學常識和高中通識教育及跨學科/課程。

另外，教城也鼓勵專業教師、非政府機構和教育機構把優質資源分享到「教學資源庫」，方便教師獲取更多優質的教學資源，增潤課堂。為提升用戶經驗，「教學資源庫」已優化版面，使用全新界面及更強大的搜尋器，方便教師尋找適切的教學資源。截至2016年8月底，資源庫共有逾2,300,000次下載*。

Inclusion Pavilion is a multifunctional information and resources platform, geared to the needs of inclusive education development. It is well stocked with articles, teaching strategies and school-based experiences relating to different special educational needs, aiming to enhance knowledge and understanding of teachers and parents regarding common special educational needs and inclusive education policies. This will assist teachers and parents with developing proper teaching methods that can address learner diversity, promote inclusive culture, and achieve whole person development. Over 280 resources were available by the end of August 2016, and three themed seminars were held, attracting over 1,100 registrants, to provide a meeting place for teachers and parents to mingle with experts, and share ideas and experiences.

Teacher TV is an online video station, designed to support teachers' professional development. Capitalising on new media technology, this platform helps teachers consolidate their professional knowledge through online self-learning, class observation, and sharing good teaching practices in other schools. This in turn facilitates the building of an online culture that combines interactive learning and knowledge sharing with stronger bonding within professional communities. During the 2015/16 school year, 852 videos were available.

“ To be a responsible teacher and student mentor, we must always keep abreast with current knowledge of the modern world. However, teachers are always time restricted, especially those who live as far away as Tin Shui Wai, who often have to spend at least three hours travelling to and from training centres for professional training. KEY INITIATIVES 重點工作



In view of the increasing demand for eLearning tools in the classroom and beyond campus, HKEdCity launched the **Go eLearning** website to support teachers with applying the latest eLearning tools and strategies in their lessons, by referring to other teaching professionals' experience. It features videos demonstrating the use and operation of different eLearning tools, along with corresponding lesson clips and teaching tips. As at 31 August 2016, there were over 110 step-by-step video demonstrations covering four series – Classroom Interaction, Flipped Classroom, Collaborative Learning and Learning Management System – and searchable by key learning areas.

A series of offline conferences, seminars and hands-on workshops have been organised, to let teachers exchange ideas with experts and scholars from different professional areas, covering topics such as development of eLearning and eAssessment, special education programmes in both special and mainstream schools, and multimedia production for the betterment of education.

“ Go eLearning platform enables teachers to share their experiences and ideas by using various eLearning tools. Through categorised short video clips, teachers can master the recommended apps or websites for integration in their own teaching. The platform enhances interactions between teachers and students, and increases the effectiveness of their teaching and learning.

TVNews is an interactive English learning platform. It features online self-learning and assessment functions, to engage students in self-assessment for language improvement through multimedia English clips and online exercises. These exercises feature short English news clips, coupled with vocabulary and comprehension exercises, as well as discussions to help students to sharpen their listening, reading, writing and speaking skills, in addition to stimulating their interest and developing their skills in critical thinking regarding social issues.

During 2015/16, TVNews was widely promoted to primary and secondary schools as a whole-year programme consisting of exercises for school terms and Award Scheme during summer holidays. It attracted participation by 630 schools – representing almost 59% of schools in Hong Kong – and engaged 20,000 unique users during the year, who learned about English and current affairs.

“ Students can improve their listening skills and learn more vocabulary through TVNews. Besides, they can become more concerned about Hong Kong. ”

「**TVNews**」集網上自學和學習評估於一身，學生可透過多媒體英語短片和網上練習自學，提升語文能力。練習包括英語新聞短片，配以詞彙、理解練習和討論題，讓學生訓練聽、說、讀、寫能力，並提升他們對社會時事的興趣和明辨性思考。

於2015/16學年，「TVNews」以學年計劃形式推廣至中小學，分學期提供練習，並推出暑期獎勵計劃，全年共吸引了630所學校參與，覆蓋全港約59%學校，年間有逾20,000名用戶透過「TVNews」學習英語及時事知識。

為進一步鼓勵小學生在暑假期間閱讀及學習英文，教城與Scholastic合辦「**Summer English**」，透過涵蓋不同主題和有趣的篇章，如民間傳說、故事、文章等，助小學生學習英文。該計劃共吸引200間學校參加，共有5,681名學生參與。

Chinese Campus was launched last year, to support Chinese teaching and students' learning needs. The platform collects self-learning activities and teaching resources which are categorised into six main learning areas at primary and secondary levels: reading, writing, listening and speaking, literature and Chinese culture, language knowledge, as well as learning and teaching for Non-Chinese Speaking (NCS) students. By 31 August 2016, there were 70 teaching resources and 46 entertaining online learning tasks available for teachers and students to use.

“ Chinese Campus enables students to learn Chinese through online exercises, and provides diverse learning materials. Students can choose their favourite activities, like Reading Comprehension, eWorks, Current Affairs, Classical Chinese, Language Knowledge and Vocabulary, to enhance their Chinese knowledge. We have participated in Summer Chinese. We can see that students have improved their Chinese standards through online exercises and games. It's really pleasing that our students have won awards in the Chinese Campus competition. ”

Summer Science is a summer incentive scheme, which encourages students to engage in the world of science and mathematics via game-based learning. It is designed to promote and facilitate self-learning related to science in the General Studies and Mathematics curricula at primary school level. Rich multimedia learning contents contributed by Children Science are conveyed through exciting games, which fully realise the effectiveness of game-based learning and increase students' engagement. During 2015/16, the platform engaged 21,328 unique users from 293 primary schools. The top five schools would participate in an offline final at the end of October 2016, to compete for the highest honour.

“ Our school has participated in Summer Science for the past few years, to let students learn and challenge themselves during summer. Through the scheme, some students have gained knowledge beyond what they learnt in class. They have become more interested in Maths, Science and General Studies, as they found that many things they learnt can be applied in daily life!





Additionally, **10-minute Science**, an online learning scheme coupled with multi-media learning and diverse assessments to enrich students' knowledge of general studies and science during school calendar months, attracted participation by 205 primary schools, with more than 10,316 unique students during the school term.

“ The content of 10-minute Science is very down-to-earth. It introduces science concepts in an interesting way. The platform design is simple to use, which makes students very willing to participate in 10-minute Science exercises. 網上試題 學習平台 Online Question Bank



Online Question Bank (OQB) is an award winning online learning platform designed to facilitate ‘assessment for learning’ and ‘assessment as learning’. OQB aims to enable teachers to better understand each student’s learning progress and performance, and explore their learning potential. This helps teachers to adjust and formulate effective teaching strategies, and develop individual study plans that cater to learning diversity. It also aims to assist students in preparing for the HKDSE, and strengthening their learning ability through assessments and instant feedback.

OQB has partnered with HKEAA since 2009. In 2015/16, the platform provided over 4,500 questions from past public examination papers covering nine subjects: English Listening, Chinese Listening, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Economics, Geography and ICT. The collaboration has been expanded to content providers including the Hong Kong Educational Publishing Company, the Modern Educational Research Society, the Hong Kong Economic Journal, and Mr. Albert Wong Kin Wai – the IT Coordinator and Computer Subject Panel Head of Lee Kau Yan Memorial School, to provide almost 2,800 free questions covering Mathematics, Biology, Liberal Studies and ICT for all secondary students, so they can experience effective learning via assessment. The questions were categorised by year, topic, level of difficulty and relevance to the New Senior Secondary (NSS) curriculum. With flexible filtering tools and powerful analytical reports, students were empowered with personalised assessment and self-evaluated learning progress reports. During 2015/16, the service attracted subscriptions from 151 secondary schools and 92 individual users, covering 32% of Hong Kong secondary schools. Together with programmes delivered through OQB and paid services, there were 401 schools using the platform.



“ Our school has put a lot of effort into fostering eLearning. In recent years, we have used the Online Question Bank (OQB) platform to help students continue the learning process outside the classroom. The platform has a comprehensive question bank, and the topics are categorised according to topics and levels of difficulty, which helps students gain a top-notch learning experience. It also provides immediate feedback, enabling students to more effectively understand their progress and make improvements. Teachers can learn more about the performance of students through various types of analytical reports in the platform. They can also screen students' unsatisfactory performances and discuss them with the students, to enhance effectiveness and interactivity during the lessons. The use of the OQB Platform has made our school's performances in ICT subjects more successful than those of candidates in the same level of schools in the Hong Kong DSE exam. Last year, our school's ICT DSE exam credit rate was outstanding, reflecting the effectiveness of the OQB platform. We hope that the OQB platform can be extended to a junior level in the near future, to enhance students' after-school learning and provide instant feedback to help students gain a self-learning habit. ”

「**網上試題學習平台**」是專為「促進學習評估」及「作為學習的評估」而設，並曾獲獎項的網上學習平台。平台服務旨在助教師掌握每名學生的學習進度和表現，並發掘其學習潛能，以調節及制定有效的教學策略，就個別學生設計針對性的學習計劃，從而拉近學習差異。另一方面，平台亦希望支援學生準備香港中學文憑考試，助他們透過評估和即時回饋鞏固所學知識。

自2009年起，平台獲香港考試及評核局支持，於2015/16學年提供超過4,500條歷屆公開考試題目，包括英文聆聽、中文聆聽、數學、物理、化學、生物、經濟、地理、資訊及通訊科技科等。教城也與其他內容供應商及教師合作，包括香港教育圖書公司、現代教育研究社有限公司、信報及李求恩紀念中學的資訊科技統籌主任及電腦科科主任黃健威老師，提供約2,800條免費題目，包括數學、生物、通識教育、資訊及通訊科技科，以幫助中學生通過評估，提升學習效能。平台的題目以年份、課題、難度和與新高中課程的相關度分類，配合靈活的篩選工具和強大的分析報告，為學生提供個人化評估，透過自我評核檢視學習進程。於2015/16學年，有151所中學和92名個人用戶訂購網上試題學習平台服務，全港中學覆蓋率32%；而使用平台的免費項目及收費服務共401所學校。

“ 為推動電子教學的發展，本校一直不遺餘力。近年，本校更使用教城「網上試題學習平台」，幫助學生於課堂後繼續學習，平台設有完善的試題庫，題目亦按課題和深淺程度分類，有助學生鞏固學習和拔尖之用。學習平台亦能提供即時回饋，學生可以更有效率了解自己的學習進度，從而作出改進。老師亦可透過平台的各類分析報告，了解學生的表現，在課堂可以篩選學生表現未如理想的題目作較深入的解說，有助加強課堂的效能和互動性。使用「網上試題學習平台」後，本校資訊科技科考生在香港中學文憑試的成績比同類日校考生和全港水平為佳，去年優良率更遠高全港水平，喜見此平台的果效。本校期望「網上試題學習平台」日後能擴展至初中學科，透過平台延伸學生課後學習，提供即時回饋評估，培養學生建構自主學習。 ”

EdV, known as Educational Video, is a free school-based video platform to facilitate multimedia use in and beyond classrooms. The EdV Awards encourage the application of multimedia in learning and teaching to improve learning efficiency, and were organised for the fifth successive year in 2015/16. This year's awards attracted over 213 learning and teaching videos from 78 schools, most of which were submitted together with recommended lesson plans or learning materials and a set of multiple choice questions for student assessments. The awards reveal the participants' support for sharing amongst the community as well as promoting the concept of 'Flipped Classroom'.

During the six years of cultivation of multimedia in education, over 1,000 masterpieces were produced by in-service teachers, pre-service teachers and students, and received for sharing within the education sector. The submissions included demonstrations, experiments, thematic studies, and performances related to learning and teaching. To further cultivate the use of multimedia in schools, the school-based video service is now free for primary and secondary schools in Hong Kong to use for uploading, storing and sharing videos through their self-managed platform, while teachers and students can produce and share creative media learning and teaching resources with their peers. By the end of August 2016, there were 282 schools fully utilising this school-based service.

“ Although there are different kinds of video-sharing platforms in the market for teachers to use, EdV – provided by HKEdCity, is user-friendly and comprises cross-platform, Chinese interface and school-based elements that make it the best. Through film watching, quiz and result analysis functions, teachers can have a good grasp of students' performances, so we can adjust the teaching approach accordingly. EdV definitely helps the implementation of Flipped Classroom. ”

教城過去6年致力推動學界應用多媒體，現已收集千多段短片與學界共享，作品均由現職教師、職前教師和學生製作，內容包括課堂示範、科學實驗、學科專題研究、各項活動表演及生活百科常識等。為繼續推動多媒體教學，教城現為全港中小學提供免費短片平台服務，學校可自行管理平台，上載、儲存及分享教學短片，教師和學生也可以製作並分享他們的多媒體學與教資源。截至2016年8月，已有282所學校應用此校本服務。

Hong Kong Reading City is a popular online service which fosters Read-to-Learn and Learn-to-Read cultures among education stakeholders. It aims to build a Read and Share culture among schools, encouraging Hong Kong students to learn from extensive reading and form good reading habits. The platform provides a comprehensive range of reading services for schools, including Reading Board, Reading Contract, Online Reading Club and other online resources. By employing information technology, the Reading Contract encourages students to read on their own initiative, and systematically records their reading progress, inspirations and thoughts. Teachers can understand their students' learning behaviour and capabilities through a management system, and hence formulate appropriate reading and learning strategies. In 2015/16, 146 schools joined as 'Reading Schools', with over 1,400 students participating in the Reading Contract and over 15,500 books read.

“ Our school encourages students to browse the HKReadingCity website, where they can find newly published books, and read excerpts from books. Although each title only comprises less than 10% of the original content, all are suitable for students to read. Reading Board is the most useful resource for me to keep the school library boards up-to-date. In order to let students experience eLearning, in recent years we have encouraged them to join Reading Contract. By logging the reading records online, students can keep their reading records from Primary 1 to Primary 6 in place systematically. We encourage students, especially those who are not familiar with Chinese typing to join the summer scheme, so they can complete it at home with guidance and assistance from their parents. ”

「香港閱讀城」是深受學界持份者歡迎的教城網站，以推廣「從閱讀中學習」和「學會閱讀」為己任，支援學校宣揚「愛閱讀、樂分享」的文化，鼓勵香港學生透過閱讀學習知識，和培養他們養成良好的閱讀習慣。香港閱讀城為學校提供全面的閱讀服務，包括「閱讀壁報板」、「閱讀約章」、「網上讀書會」和其他網上資源等。「閱讀約章」運用資訊科技，鼓勵學生自行閱讀，並有系統地記錄自己的閱讀歷程、啟發和感想。教師也可以利用管理系統，檢視學生的閱讀習慣和能力，從而制定適切的閱讀及學習策略。於2015/16學年，有146所學校登記使用「悅讀學校」服務，參加「閱讀約章」的學生超過1,400人，合共閱讀超過15,500本書。

A brand new award, Publicly Recommended Books, was launched this year, to encourage our members to recommend good books to students. In all, 13,293 votes were recorded. ● Serving Students 學生服務



Small Campus is an interactive game-based learning platform. It helps primary school students develop motivation to learn and self-directed learning habits through curriculum-based content, interactive learning games, tools and theme-based activities and competitions. The revamped Small Campus was launched in October 2015. It supports cross-platform functions, and is widely compatible with different types of desktops, tablets and smartphones, for learning anytime and anywhere. The new features include teachers' recommendations to students regarding games which match their curricula, social networking among the school's buddies and leisure game corner — to provide a safe, playful virtual learning environment for young children. The revamped Small Campus attracted over 101,000 participants in 2015/16.

CAMPUS 少年Teen空



Teen Campus is a healthy learning platform with life and personal growth knowledge for teenagers, aiming to unleash their personal potential. With diverse interactive learning resources and activities, the platform encourages teenagers to learn beyond the classroom and equip themselves with 21st Century skills, and thus form a new generation with a love for exploring and sharing. The platform was revamped in June 2016, with well-organised and high quality content and programmes. It comprises diverse online learning programmes covering a variety of subjects, reading and writing, and life education – to encourage students to explore, develop a sense of social concern and develop critical thinking skills through a wealth of multi-media resources, and professional advice on difficulties they may face while growing up and on life planning.

Building on the previous year's success, HKEdCity continued collaborating with Radio Television Hong Kong for **'LS Online Challenge'** and Hong Kong Economic Journal for **'Hong Kong Liberal Studies Financial Literacy Championship'**, to equip students with basic information on social and current issues covered in the six Liberal Studies learning areas. During the year, 14,636 students from 175 schools participated in various programmes.

創作天地 eWorks

eWorks is an online writing platform that encourages students to write and share. Coupled with the awards scheme to recognise outstanding writing submitted by primary and secondary students, the platform attracted 1,680 submissions in 2015/16, with participation by 165 schools.

Learning & Teaching Expo




The Learning & Teaching Expo (LTE) is an annual regional event through which teachers, school leaders and educators in Asia can discover the latest developments in educational resources and learning technology. The Expo serves as an opportunity for everyone involved in providing education to exchange ideas about learning and teaching in the 21st century. HKEdCity jointly organised the Expo in 2015/16 – its sixth year, with an international professional exhibition organiser, Diversified Communications Hong Kong, and received full support from the Education Bureau, UK Trade and Investment, the UK’s National Association for Special Education Needs (nasen) and the British Educational Supplies Association.

This led to an overwhelming response from participants, with 228 exhibition booths, including UK and Finland pavilions, showcasing the latest overseas learning solutions and products, together with more than 160 conferences, forums, workshops and school visits presented and led by internationally renowned scholars and local professionals. These features helped to attract over 9,000 unique visitors, 72.8% of whom were from Hong Kong, with others from countries and regions including China, Taiwan, Macau, Singapore, South Korea, South East Asia, Australia, New Zealand, Canada, the USA, Egypt, Finland, France, Norway, and the UK. The Expo not only provides a platform for connecting local education professionals, but also allows them to participate in international exchanges regarding the latest ideas about education.



Parent Academy is a one-stop online resources platform for parents. It collects articles, videos and information from various professional institutions and experts, and groups them into three major categories: 'Parenting and Growth', 'Learning Support' and 'Future Planning'. Focused on more than just school results, the platform is committed to helping parents develop their children's proper behaviour, attitudes and positive values, to nurture whole person development for new generations and allow parents to learn and grow with their children.



Eight events for Parent Education on eLearning were organised jointly with AiTLE and the Education Bureau in different districts during 2015/16. Each event included seminars conducted by professionals and experts in parenting education, and innovative lessons taught by experienced teachers, for parents to understand and experience eLearning, equipping them to become their children's companions in learning journeys. Almost 500 parents were reached.

EdPost provides the latest trends in education and shares valuable expert insight for subscribers. It has been enriched, such as through incorporating an educational newspaper that features education news, talk-of-the-town topics, and the latest learning and teaching resources and information updates. Both HKEdCity members and non-members can subscribe to EdPost via email. By the end of August 2016, there were almost 103,000 subscriptions.

● Technology and Infrastructure 技術和基礎設施

There was further work on migrating internal systems to cloud services on a small scale. More systems are expected to be migrated in the coming years. The WiFi single sign-on service with WiFi testing tools has been successfully deployed in the cloud, to take full advantage of the scalability, reliability and flexible cost structure of cloud infrastructure.

Video for education use is increasingly popular, and the demands for video bandwidth and storage are increasing. A third party cloud-based video solution has been piloted, to improve the cost effectiveness and scalability of delivering video in various services. The video solution can also provide mobile access and an improved user experience.

The infrastructure has been stable recently, and there was no major service failure in 2015/16. Security audits related to systems and operations have been conducted and there were no major non-compliance issues.

教城過去小規模地將一些內部系統遷移至雲端，並將於未來進一步進行系統遷移的工作。基於雲端服務可靠及容易擴展，成本亦易於控制，WiFi單一登入服務及WiFi測試工具早前已順利安置於雲端。

隨着使用影片教學愈來愈普及，對影片頻寬及儲存的需求亦愈來愈大。教城藉著雲端服務供應商的服務方案，試行將影片轉移至雲端，以改善成本效益及將影片用於其他服務的可擴展性，同時支援流動裝置及改善用家體驗。

基礎設施的運作已非常穩定，於2015/16年度並無發生重大服務問題。教城亦已就系統及運作進行相關的安全審計，並無重大不合規格事宜。



SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT 可持續發展



Operated largely with the support of government funds, HKEdCity upholds a high standard of corporate governance, maintains reliable and accurate financial reporting and emphasises social responsibility in order to ensure sustainable development of the Company.

教城的經營資金主要來自政府，故奉行高水平的企業管治，維持可靠和準確的財務報告，並強調社會責任，以確保公司可持續發展。



● Corporate Governance 企業管治

Governance Structure*

In 2015/16, the Board of Directors had 11 members, who were appointed by shareholders. The Board is the highest governing body, overseeing the Company's strategic development and ensuring it operates in compliance with statutory requirements. Under the Board, the Executive Committee is typically chaired by the official Director, to monitor and give advice on the Company's operational matters. Further, the Business Development Committee governs all the Company's business developments, including EdMall and EdConnect, etc.

During 2015/16, three Board Meetings, three Executive Committee Meetings and one Business Development Committee Meeting were held, with attendance rates of 82%, 92% and 84%, respectively. Declarations of interest were made by all Directors for the year. No director received any remuneration.

As of 31 August 2016, the Company maintained a total headcount of 63, with three divisions: Systems and Operation, Development, and Administration and Finance. The most up-to-date Organisation Chart is in Appendix 1.

管治架構*

2015/16年度，董事會有11名成員，由股東任命，組成機構最高的領導層，負責監管公司的發展策略，並確保其運作符合法定要求。董事會下設執行委員會，由官方董事擔任主席，負責定期監察公司的營運，及提供建議。此外，業務發展委員會則負責監管公司的業務發展，包括「教城購物廣場」及「EdConnect用戶目錄服務」等。

2015/16年期間，教城舉行了3次董事會會議、3次執行委員會會議及1次業務發展委員會會議，出席率分別為82%、92%及84%。全體董事已申報本年度的利益，概無董事收取任何酬金。

教城由系統及營運部、發展部和行政及財務部三個部門組成，截至2016年8月31日，員工總數為63人。最新的公司架構圖見附錄一。

Risk Management

HKEdCity has a Risk Management Policy in place to govern risk management. In 2015/16, the risk register was updated, and measures to address the identified risks were implemented. We also revised the internal audit plan to prioritise and assess the potential risks that may occur in the changing business environment. The risk mitigation measures were implemented accordingly. Audit exercises concerning website content management and system security were conducted. No significant issue was observed during the audits.

HKEdCity also constantly reviews and streamlines its policies and procedures. In 2015/16, the policies and guidelines relating to official entertainment and financial management were revised in order to support the business development. Besides, the new policy on intellectual rights and copyright, and website content management guidelines, were established to strengthen governance of the website contents.

風險管理

教城制定了風險管理政策以監察公司的風險。在2015/16年度，教城更新了風險登記冊，並積極採取一些緩解措施以減低存在的風險。我們亦修訂了內部審計計劃，重新評估及監察潛在的風險。風險緩解措施也相應地推行了。本年度的審計項目包括網站內容管理及系統保安檢測。全部均如期完成，並無發現重大的風險問題。

同時，教城亦不斷檢討及簡化其政策和程序。在2015/16年度，教城修訂了有關公務酬酢及財務管理政策及指引，以配合業務的發展。為了加強網站內容的管理，我們亦制定了有關知識產權及版權政策及網站內容管理指引。

Staff Development

As staff members are among the most valuable assets of a company, HKEdCity places great emphasis on organising staff development programmes and activities, to enhance the capability of staff as well as promote staff relations and morale.

員工發展

教城視員工為公司最寶貴的資產。因此，教城十分重視推動員工發展計劃和組織員工活動，從而提高員工工作能力，以及維繫員工之間的關係和提升士氣。





Staff Training and Team Building

The Company strives to provide staff development programmes to enhance the professional skills and knowledge of its staff members, in order to meet business needs and the challenges ahead. Staff members were nominated to attend external seminars and conferences, as well as various training workshops and seminars, which included topics such as problem solving skills, project management, EdBookShelf operation, web content management, learning management system and occupation health and safety. During the year, approximately 129 man-days were invested in staff training, and the average training time per member of staff was approximately 2.1 man-days.

To promote staff relations and morale, the Company also organised various staff activities including a Christmas Party and a New Year Lunch. Recreational and healthy activities like badminton and fruit days were also organised, to promote a healthy lifestyle.

教城致力為員工提供培訓計劃，提高員工的專業技能和知識，以滿足業務需求和迎接挑戰。獲提名的員工可參加外間機構舉辦的研討會和會議，以及各種培訓工作坊，其內容涉及解決問題技巧、項目管理、教城書櫃之運作、網上內容管理，學習管理系統及職業健康及安全等。年內，教城投放了約129天於員工培訓，平均每名員工的培訓時間約為2.1天。

為了增進員工之間的關係和提升士氣，教城還組織各種員工活動，包括聖誕派對、團年飯等；另外亦舉辦了不同的康樂活動如羽毛球及水果日，以推廣健康的生活方式。



Pay Structure and Benefits Review

To maintain the competitiveness of our remuneration packages in retaining talent, HKEdCity conducted a review of its pay structure and benefit provisions on a three-year cycle basis, according to the major principles and strategies laid down in the policy. All the recommendations were adopted by the Board. The Board also approved the budget for salary increments and performance incentives for 2015/16. The total remuneration of the top three tiers of management amounted to HK\$8.53 million.

薪酬結構和福利檢討

為了保持在招聘和挽留人才方面的市場競爭力，教城根據公司政策制定的準則和策略，於2015/16進行了三年一度的薪酬結構和福利檢討，而有關建議亦獲董事會通過。此外，董事會亦批准薪酬調整和2015/16年度表現獎金的發放，最高三層管理人員的薪酬合共853萬港元。



● Financial Report 財務報告

HKEdCity continues to maintain prudent and effective use of public money which complies with statutory accounting requirements, and maintains a healthy financial status with adequate financial planning and control as well as proper financial records.

In the 2015/16 financial year, the Company continued to sustain a healthy and steady financial position. The total income and expenditure of subvented activities for the year was HK\$36 million. As of 31 August 2016, the Company had non-current assets of HK\$4.4 million and current assets of HK\$22.3 million in total. Net assets of the Company amounted to HK\$1.5 million. Cash coupon donations totalling HK\$3,000 were received, and the funds were designated for eLearning development and promotion of better learning and teaching through our services. Overall, the Company's liquidity was in a very good condition throughout the year, as cash and bank deposits amounted to HK\$21 million by the end of the financial year. The accounts for subvented and non-subvented activities were kept separately.

在2015/16財政年度，公司繼續保持穩健的財務狀況。本年度受資助活動的總收入和支出均為36,018,648港元。截至2016年8月31日，公司非流動資產及流動資產總額分別為4,368,479港元及22,310,808港元。公司的資產淨值總額為1,452,352港元。教城亦接受了3,000港元的現金禮券捐贈用作推廣電子學習及教城的各項學與教服務。總括而言，公司全年保持良好的資產流動性，截至2016年8月31日止的年度現金及銀行存款總額達21,018,936港元。政府資助和非政府資助活動的帳目是明確分開的。

Expenditure of Subvented Activities

Regarding the expenditure for subvented activities, staff costs totalled HK\$24.1 million, accounting for 67% of the total expenditure.

As for capital expenditure, HKEdCity spent HK\$0.9 million to acquire fixed assets including computer equipment, software licences and office facilities.

政府資助活動的支出

政府資助活動的開支方面，員工薪酬開支總額為24,131,708港元，佔67%，為總支出最大的份額。

資本開支方面，教城支出共937,856港元以購買固定資產，包括電腦設備、軟件和辦公室設備。



Reserve

According to the current Service Agreement dated 6 October 2011, HKEdCity is allowed to keep a reserve at a level capped at 25% of the current year's subvention. Therefore, HK\$5.7 million of unused subvention was carried forward and kept as reserve in 2015/16. The accumulated reserve to be carried forward to 2016/17 is HK\$7 million.

The expenses of the Staff Fund amounted to HK\$44,199.10 (74.2% of the approved budget), which was derived from the retained earnings for organising staff relations events. As of 31 August 2016, HKEdCity maintained its retained earnings of HK\$1.5 million from its non-subvented activities.

儲備

根據2011年10月6日簽訂的服務協議，教城可保留以本年度政府資助金額的25%為上限作為儲備。2015/16年度共有5,734,890.58港元未動用政府資助金獲結轉並用作儲備，累積結轉至2016/17年度的儲備為6,956,108.09港元。

本年度員工基金的開支為44,199.10港元（核准預算的74.2%），該款項是從留存收益撥出以用作籌組員工活動之用途。截至2016年8月31日，來自非政府資助活動的留存收益為1,452,350港元。

External Audit

In May 2016, Patrick Wong C.P.A. Limited, Chartered Accountants, Certified Public Accountants (Practising), Hong Kong was reappointed as the Company auditors for this fiscal year in May 2016, and the reappointment was endorsed in the Annual General Meeting. The annual stocktaking exercise for all fixed assets was completed on 31 August 2016. The annual external audit and compliance audit for the year-ended 31 August 2016 was completed successfully and full compliance with statutory requirements was achieved.

外部審核

2016年5月，股東周年大會通過公司續聘黃龍德會計師事務所有限公司，香港執業會計師為本財政年度的核數師。一年一度的固定資產盤點已於2016年8月31日完成，教城更順利完成了對截至2016年8月31日止的財政年度的外部審核和合規性審核，報告反映各項目均符合法定要求。



● Corporate Social Responsibility 企業社會責任

Shouldering corporate social responsibility to the community is one of HKEdCity's missions. Our ongoing contributions to society have been widely recognised. During the year, the Social Capital Builder Award, Gold Award of the Web Accessibility Recognition Scheme, Caring Company Award, Family-Friendly Employer Award, Good MPF Employer Award and Caring for People Award – Certificate of Excellence of HSBC Living Business Awards 2016 were received. We are committed not only to providing a quality workplace to our staff, but also to promoting prudent operating practices, remaining active in the community, and creating a positive impact in the community.

- In order to provide staff with a quality and safe work environment, HKEdCity has family-friendly policies such as paternity leave, marriage leave, compassionate leave, and compensation leave. HKEdCity also implements various occupational health measures in order to promote and enhance staff health and safety at work.
- During the year, HKEdCity also supported its voluntary team and staff to participate in voluntary or charity activities or services such as UNICEF Charity Run 2015 and Loving Kids Community Roller Skating Carnival 2015.
- HKEdCity's obsolete office computers and accessories were donated to Caritas Computer Refurbish Project, which aims to recycle computers for people in need.
- Aiming to promote the importance of social responsibility to vendors, HKEdCity stipulates procurement specifications requiring vendors to meet the minimum wage requirement, protect intellectual property rights and personal data, observe health and safety standards, etc.


