Go eLearning (www.hkedcity.net/goelearning) supports teachers intending to apply eLearning strategies in their teaching by gathering teachers' experiences. It features videos demonstrating the use and operation of different eLearning tools, corresponding lesson clips and teaching tips.

- Consists of 4 series: 'Classroom Interaction', 'Flipped Classroom', 'Collaborative Learning' and 'Learning Management Systems'.
- Keep abreast with latest eLearning trends.
- Tools are searchable by key learning areas (KLA).
- Step-by-step video demonstration of using different tools.
- Lesson clips to demonstrate the implementation and effectiveness of different eLearning tools.
- Teachers' tips and experience on using particular tools.
- Related teaching materials are downloadable and ready to use.





EdV

EdV (www.hkedcity.net/edv), known as Educational Video, is a free school-based video platform facilitating multimedia learning and teaching.

- The platform contains no commercial or advertising elements.
- Schools can assign access rights of different videos to designated classes or different groups. Videos can also be shared to the public.
- HKEdCity EdV channel (www.hkedcity.net/edv/hke) provides diversified educational videos covering a wide range of subjects.
- Teachers can register for school-based EdV service at www.hkedcity.net/registration/edv.



'Flipped Classroom' with EdV

- Teachers can set multiple-choice questions as assessment for each video.
- Auto-marking and instant feedback function for the questions.
- Students' answers, time of submission and video viewing time are recorded.
- Student performance and item analysis data reports are available.



EdV Award Scheme

- The annual award scheme (www.hkedcity.net/edv-award) encourages teachers, students and the public to produce and share creative educational videos.
- Outstanding works are showcased at HKEdCity EdV channel.
- Seminars and workshops are organised to demonstrate video production skills and video editing applications.





English Campus (www.hkedcity.net/english) is an interactive English eLearning platform for students and teachers. It features engaging, practical resources to facilitate self-directed learning and effective teaching.

Interactive English Videos

- Diverse videos, including stories, everyday English, videos for fun and about the world.
- All videos come with subtitles and dictionary function, displaying pronunciations, explanations and examples.
- Some highlighted videos feature vocabulary learning and recording functions. Students can record their speech and get scored.

Film Highlights and Learning Resources

- Latest film information and trailers in English.
- Recommended resources such as eBooks, online exercises, articles, etc.

TVNews

- News Archive features local bilingual news for the last 12 months.
- Online exercises based on selected news of around 2 minutes are updated weekly. Vocabulary, comprehension exercises and discussion questions help students learn English, develop critical thinking skills and raise their awareness of social issues.
- Auto-marking and teacher reports are available for the exercises (Junior and Senior levels).
- Award Scheme to recognise schools and students with outstanding performance and active participation.





Chinese Campus (www.hkedcity.net/chinese) supports Chinese learning and teaching for primary and secondary school students. The platform offers self-learning activities and teaching resources in 6 main learning areas, including reading, writing, listening and speaking, literature and Chinese culture, language knowledge, as well as learning and teaching for non-Chinese speaking (NCS) students.

Self-learning Exercises

5 categories of exercises include:

- Reading Comprehension: auto-marking eWorksheets based on theories of reading.
- Current Affairs: local news videos with exercises to increase students' ability in analysing information.
- Classical Chinese: games about classic works.
- Language Knowledge: games about Chinese language knowledge.
- Vocabulary: games for NCS students and primary students to arouse their learning interest.

Recommended Teaching Resources

- A wide range of latest quality Chinese resources and websites are consolidated.
- Series of Chinese eBooks with interactive exercises or multimedia support are recommended for teachers or students' self-learning.
- Diverse resources and tools, as well as teaching tips sharing from schools, to support NCS learning and teaching.





Online Question Bank (OQB) (www.hkedcity.net/oqb) is an online learning platform designed to facilitate 'Assessment for Learning'. OQB has partnered with Hong Kong Examinations and Assessment Authority (HKEAA) since 2009 as well as different content providers, and its question base has been continuously growing.

Question Bank with Rich Contents

- Features past papers from HKEAA and latest HKDSE questions which are updated annually. Items from different content providers, such as publishers and teachers, are also available.
- A collection of over 7,000 questions, among which over 2,000 are free.
- All questions are categorised by subject, topic, level of difficulty and year. Relevant information and detailed elaboration are also available for some items.
- Auto-marking function is available.
- Offers different test modes, such as simulated tests and instant answer reviews.
- Allows random display of options / questions in a test paper.
- Teachers can assign test papers to designated classes or groups to cater for students' learning differences.



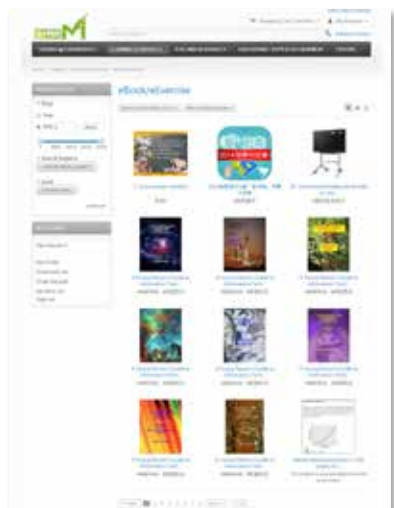
Detailed Evaluation Reports

- School-based assessment reports are available, including comparison of students' performances and study progress reports.
- Students can access the test paper analyses and personal performance reports for self-evaluation.



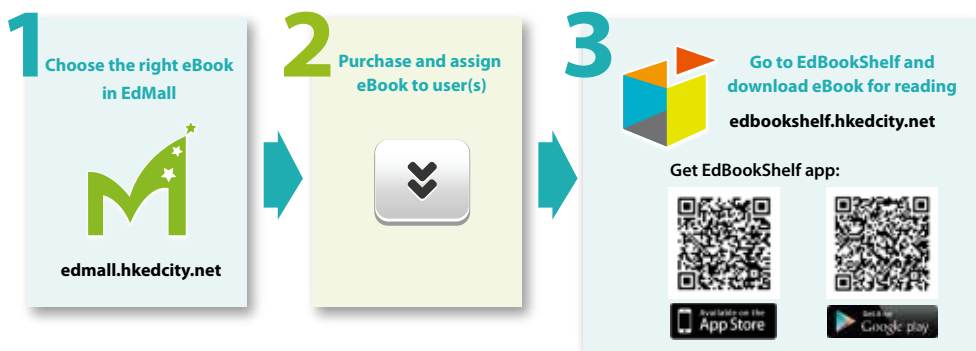
EdMall (edmall.hkedcity.net) is a one-stop online marketplace for learning and teaching resources, providing schools, teachers, students, parents and business partners with quick, easy and secure online transaction service, as well as share / comment functions.

- Features a large number of diversified, quality learning and teaching resources, educational supplies and equipment.
- Connected with EdBookShelf for users to select and view eBooks.
- Discounts and segmented pricing are possible for different groups or on bulk purchase. Free products are available for schools or individuals from time to time.
- Flexible payment methods: Cheque is accepted for school purchase within 45 calendar days.
- Multiple product delivery methods, e.g. downloadable file and key activation. For physical products, users can contact the supplier on the platform for delivery arrangement.
- Schools, teachers and parents may buy products and services with their HKEdCity accounts, and assign them to designated groups or individual student.



Start your innovative and fruitful eLearning Journey with **EdBookShelf** (www.hkedcity.net/edbookshelf). Over 300 free eBooks are now available.

- Single sign-on function and cloud synchronisation on eBooks, personalised setting and notes across different platforms.
- Supports offline reading on tablets.
- Text-to-Speech function in Cantonese/Putonghua/English to facilitate students' language learning.
- Built-in learning tools are available for users to record their learning progress, e.g. free-writing, drawing, highlighting, book-marking, note-taking and annotation functions.
- Multimedia contents are supported, e.g. 2D/3D pictures, audio, videos, hyperlinks and interactive exercises.



eRead Scheme (www.hkedcity.net/ereadscheme) is a school-based eBook subscription service to promote reading culture. When school year begins, participating schools select and subscribe to a list of eBooks. All students and teachers will then enjoy unlimited access to the eBooks during the subscription period.

- eBooks in different booklists are selected by specialists and experienced pilot schools.
- Different reading packages are offered while collection of eBooks will keep growing.
- Promote reading effectively at minimal cost: around \$10 per student each year. At least 100 eBooks are available.
- Simple subscription process and reduced administrative efforts.
- Students read their eBooks on the cross-platform, multi-functional eBook reader 'EdBookShelf' and develop the habit of self-directed learning.
- More possibilities in learning activities as students can read any book any time, anywhere.
- School librarians and teachers can analyse students' reading habits with data collected on EdBookShelf via eRead Scheme, and formulate right strategies to promote reading and enhance teaching effectiveness.



Hong Kong Reading City (www.hkreadingcity.net) provides book information suitable for students, encouraging them to learn from reading and fostering a 'Read and Share' culture in schools.

Book Resources

- Daily book recommendation with trial reading of over 5,000 books available online.
- Search for books and check if they are available in Public Libraries.
- Bilingual interface with clear categories of books.



Annual '10 Books Selection'

- Students, teachers and the public elect their favourite books and celebrate the works of authors and publishers.
- 'Active Participation Award for School' committing to promoting reading.

'Reading School' Service

- 'Reading Contract' for students to record their reading progress. Students who have completed the programme will receive an e-certificate. Teachers can understand the reading habits and capabilities of students through online reports.
- 'Reading Board' with thematic book recommendations are available for download and can be posted on backdrops as a noticeboard decoration.

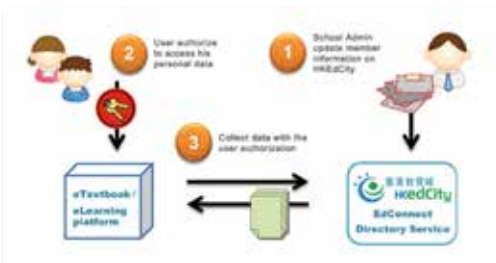


EdConnect

EdConnect (www.hkedcity.net/waaschool) rides on the current HKEdCity membership system, enabling teachers, students and other users to get access to different eLearning resources and platforms. Since 2014, the EdConnect service has been extended to support school WiFi authentication using HKEdCity account for schools to manage their WiFi network.

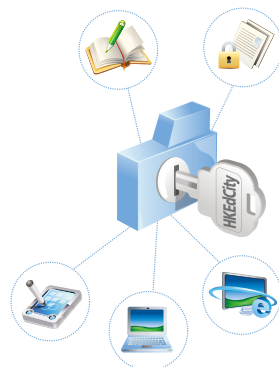
Single Sign-on Service

- Log in to different online learning platforms with a single HKEdCity account. eTextbooks, multimedia learning materials or other resources are easily accessible.
- Individual service providers can obtain school data only at the discretion of the school.
- School-based 'Resources and Tools Management' Page (or 'School Page') (www.hkedcity.net/schoolpage) to manage free/paid eResources.
- Teachers manage resources by level and learning area for students' direct access.
- More quality eLearning resources will be added and connected with EdConnect for teachers and students.



WaaSchool WiFi Authentication Service

- Schools can use the HKEdCity accounts for authentication to authorise legitimate school users to connect to WiFi at school, saving them the trouble of managing multiple accounts.
- Schools can enjoy value-added services to manage their WiFi network with ease, such as allowing a specific level or class of students to have access to WiFi, or limiting the number of devices each user can connect to the WiFi network.



Inclusion Pavilion (www.hkedcity.net/sen) is a multifunctional information and resources platform geared to the needs of inclusive education development. It is well-stocked with articles, teaching strategies and school-based experiences relating to different special educational needs (SEN), aiming to enhance the knowledge and understanding of teachers and parents about common SEN and inclusive education policies. This will assist them in developing proper pedagogies and methodologies that effectively address learning diversity, promote inclusive culture and achieve whole person development.

- Various resources, reference and information regarding SEN are available, with focus on 'Specific Learning Difficulties/Dyslexia', 'Attention Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD)' and 'Autism Spectrum Disorders', which are the common SEN types in mainstream schools.
- Different cases are provided through interviews with schools and scholars with extensive experience in promoting inclusive education and catering for learning diversity.
- In collaboration with professional institutions, seminars on different SEN topics are held for teachers and parents.
- Various professional bodies and specialists to provide online counselling services on 'Inclusive Education Forum'.
- Sharing of resources and experience is encouraged to build community support.

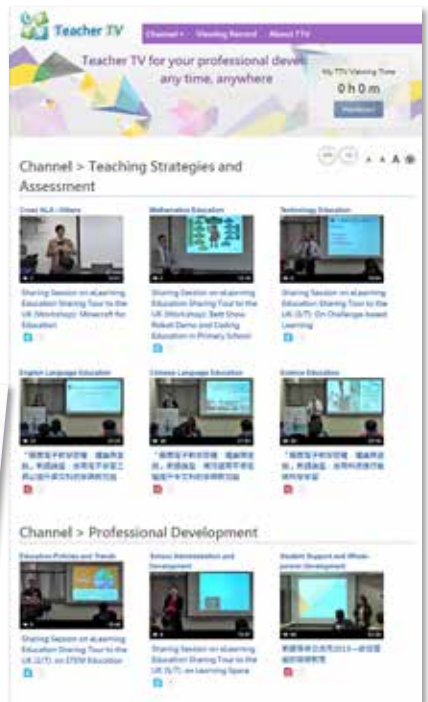


TTV



Teacher TV (TTV) (www.hkedcity.net/ttv) supports the professional development of teachers. It features over 800 videos for online self-learning, class observation and good teaching practices from schools. Teachers can accumulate Continuing Professional Development (CPD) hours at the same time.

- With HKEdCity teacher accounts, teachers have full access to videos of class lessons, professional seminars from 14 learning areas and professional development categories, as well as the related downloadable notes and reference materials.
- Viewing time is automatically recorded. Teachers can view and print their viewing records and apply for CPD hours.
- Teachers can exchange ideas and learn from other fellow teachers.
- Featured videos include 'The Chief Executive's Award for Teaching Excellence (CEATE) Showcase', 'Teachers' Professional Experience Sharing Month', 'Learning & Teaching Expo', etc.
- The platform supports different browsers and devices including desktop computers, tablets and smartphones.





Learning & Teaching Expo

Learning & Teaching Expo (LTE) (www.hkedcity.net/lte) is an annual platform for school leaders, teachers and educators to exchange professional ideas and experience, with an aim of creating mutual benefits for learning and teaching. As a diversified educational expo, LTE serves as a hub for elite educators and industry stakeholders from Hong Kong, the Asia-Pacific region and other parts of the world to introduce innovations and latest trends in education.

- LTE provides teachers with a wide range of educational products and services, with onsite support and special offers.
- Showcases the latest trends and innovations in education, ranging from teaching pedagogies, learning suites to classroom furniture.
- Series of keynote presentations, seminars and forums by world-class scholars and experts to foster professional communications on hot educational topics.
- Open classrooms by experienced in-service teachers to showcase effective pedagogies and how to integrate technologies and eLearning tools into lessons of different subjects.
- School visits for teachers to gain insights from successful cases and practical experiences of other schools.
- Networking platform for educational institutes and non-profit organisations from Hong Kong, mainland China and the Asia-Pacific region.
- Free admission for educators and industry stakeholders.





Small Campus (www.smallcampus.net) is a game-based interactive learning platform tailor-made for primary students to stimulate their learning motivation and self-directed learning habit through interactive games and knowledge in life.

Interactive Learning Games

- A wide range of educational games covering different subjects including Chinese Language, English Language, Mathematics and General Studies.
- The games are categorised into two learning levels: 'P1-3' and 'P4-6'.
- 'Special Tasks' during holidays for students to take part in, e.g. thematic activities and games.

Personalised Learning Environment

- Members can get virtual coins as they finish games and missions, and use them to buy accessories or household items in the virtual environment, thus learning how to manage their finances.
- Members have their own personalised avatar, pet, etc. and can communicate with other members.



Mathematics / Science Challenges

- '10-Minute Science' / 'Winter Science' / 'Summer Science': Enhance students' awareness in environmental protection and their interest in science through online learning platforms and fun games.
- 'Innovations in Science and Environmental Studies': Develop students' sense of innovation from planning to producing the exhibits.



Languages

- 'eWorks': Encourage students to write and share their works with others.
- 'Summer English': Increases students' exposure to and interest in English through online learning platform.



Knowledge in Life

- 'Fun Post': Comics, articles and multimedia for students to learn about languages, science and knowledge in everyday life.

- 'EdV': Educational videos on various topics, such as current affairs, scientific experiments and moral education.



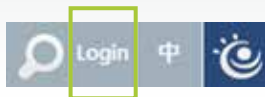
Parent Academy (www.hkedcity.net/parent) is a one-stop online resources platform for parents. It features articles, videos and information from professional institutions and experts on proper behaviours, positive attitudes and values, helping parents nurture children for their whole person development, as well as encouraging them to grow together with their children. 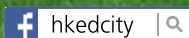
